RE: Executive Summary – State Forfeiture grant to Special Olympics

Action:

The Key West Police Department intends to donate \$1,500.00 from State Forfeiture Funds to Special Olympics Florida Monroe County. This request complies with the requirements of Florida Statute Section 932.7055. This donation will help Special Olympics Monroe County offset operational expenditures and help fund program related activities.

Background:

Each year Special Olympics Florida Monroe County sends qualifying athletes to the State Summer Games in Orlando in May. This year, they have a record number of people that have qualified to participate in the sports of Soccer, Bocce, Cycling, and Cheerleading. Special Olympics Florida Monroe County provides essential services to our community. We want to ensure that all program related activities are funded, to include all qualifying athletes being able to attend the Summer Games.

Financial Impact:

The requested funds will come from the department's State Law Enforcement Officers Trust Fund.
