A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE ROTARY CLUB TO CONDUCT A FUNDRAISER AT MCCOY INDIGENOUS PARK JULY 4TH, 2011 (SET UP JULY 2, 2011) FROM 5:00 P.M. TO 10:00 P.M. ; AUTHORIZING FIREWORKS DISPLAY OFF THE WHITE STREET PIER ON JULY 4, 2011 FROM 8:00 P.M. TO 10:00 P.M; GRANTING AN EXEMPTION FROM THE NOISE CONTROL ORDINANCE PURSUANT TO SECTION 6-86 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES DURING THE JULY 4TH FIREWORKS CELEBRATION; AUTHORIZING THE SALE AND CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES AT MCCOY INDIGENOUS PARK; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Commission of the City of Key West, Florida;

SECTION 1. That the Rotary Club is hereby granted permission to conduct the Fundraiser on the day and during the hours stated above; **PROVIDED** that all trash is adequately collected and contained; that a guarantee indemnifying the City is executed; and that the organization meet the terms and conditions set forth by the City Manager.

SECTION 2. That the Rotary Club is hereby granted a Special Event Permit under section 6-86 of the Key West Code of Ordinances for an event that will take place and time herein described.

SECTION 3. That pursuant to Section 18-86 of the Key West Code of Ordinances the Rotary Club is hereby granted permission allowing the sale and consumption of alcoholic beverages.

SECTION 4. That the Rotary Club of Key West will adhere to the recycling plan of the

City of Key West, that one (1) recycling container for every one (1) trash barrels will be used and that they will be placed side by side.

SECTION 5. That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signatures of the presiding officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
