A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING INTEGRITY MULTISPORT INC. TO CONDUCT THE "SOUTHERNMOST HALF MARATHON" ON SUNDAY, OCTOBER 11, 2026, FROM 7:00 A.M. TO 10:30 A.M. (SETUP FRIDAY, OCTOBER 10, 2026 FROM 2:00 P.M. TO 5:00 P.M.); RACE WILL START AND END AT HIGGS BEACH; AUTHORIZING CERTAIN STREET CLOSURES THEREOF DURING THE EVENT; PURSUANT TO TERMS AND CONDITIONS SET FOR BY THE CITY MANAGER; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Integrity Multisport, Inc. has applied to the city for a Special Event Permit for the "Southernmost Half Marathon" to take place on Saturday, October 11, 2026, beginning and ending at Higgs Beach and running within the streets of Key West.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Commission of the City of Key West, Florida.

SECTION 1. That in Resolution 19-174, the City Commission directed the City Manager to "develop language that restricts the use of polystyrene by individuals on public property, temporary vendors on public property, or entities engaged in a contractual relationship with the local government for the provision of good or services, unless such use is otherwise preempted by law."

SECTION 2. That the vendor/lessee/licensee acknowledges the City's concern about the negative environmental impact of using disposable polystyrene products, which are neither readily recyclable nor biodegradable. Vendor/lessee/licensee/contractor

therefore commits to refrain from the use of distribution of single-use polystyrene/plastic items, including but not limited to single-use polystyrene/plastic straws, bags, plastic utensils and "to go" packages for food or products sold on any property leased from the City."

SECTION 3. That Integrity Multisport, Inc. is hereby granted a Special Event Permit under Section 6-86 of the Key West Code of Ordinances for an event that will take place at the time and place as herein described; PROVIDED that all trash is adequately collected and contained; that a guarantee indemnifying the city is executed; and that the organization meets the terms and conditions set forth by the City Manager.

SECTION 4. That Integrity Multisport, Inc. will adhere to the recycling plan of the City of Key West, that one (1) recycling container for every one (1) trash barrels will be used and that they will be placed side by side.

SECTION 5. That Integrity Multisport, Inc. acknowledges that they are responsible for payment to the Key West Police Department, the Key West Fire Department and Community Services.

SECTION 6. That this resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signatures of the presiding officer and Clerk of the Commission.
