Art Show and sidewalk art on pavement of pier. Visitors could walk the entire pier looking at various art booths with the harbor as dominate backdrop view.

Fishing Tournament headquarters. Communication and fish weighing with boats and yachts parked along inner wall.

Viking Yachts, Grady White, Intrepid, SeaVee Boats to name a few all conduct manufacturers days with 1000's of people on 100's of boats. Manufacturers seek to build brand value by staging customer appreciation events, in the water safety meetings, shore side games and parties.

Ferry Boat Docking to travel to Cuba, one or two days a week passengers could be loaded from an off site parking area. *WHEN APPROVED BY STATE DEPARTMENT AND GOVT OF CUBA.*

Wave Runner Races, an increasingly popular sport as it is more affordable for young people to get started in.

Sailing Regattas, Pier could be used as Yacht Center central location. Meeting site and viewing area along with start and finish point of race. Thousands of people would walk the pier to view sailing displays and club racing in the inner harbor and also bigger boats on front side. Might be the finest location in the United States for this purpose.

Light Tackle tournaments for outboard boats. Normally two day events. weigh station could be located on inner side of basin. Tournament communications and judges on the pier. Sailfish tournaments are major economic events.

Motor Coach Club, Rally and Rendezvous, Various clubs and Motor Coach groups conduct gatherings in scenic destinations. Once or twice a year Motor Coach groups could use the pier with arguably the greatest view in the country. The pier would probably fit 100's of high end coach's. Would be very productive use economically for the city.

Tall Ships Rally, Pier could host International Tall Ships would be very scenic for city. Citizens could tour inner harbor and be educated on sailing technology while viewing static display. Watch sailing on front side of pier. Marine Heritage

Meeting point and Rally site for Power or Sail Boats traveling to Cuba and Havana. Pier would be great venue for public to view. *WHEN APPROVED BY U.S. STATE DEPT. AND GOV.T OF CUBA*

Large Yacht or Mega Yachts facility to occasionally host meeting for charter and interval ownership yachts to be displayed. Very fast growing segment of boating industry.

Nautical Flea Market, Annual event where interested people sets up a stall or tables onto pier and buys and sells surplus items for boats. Boats for sale could be on the inner side of the pier and be displayed. 1000's of Keys folks could walk about. Great opportunity for public awareness of water quality, boating safety, Sanctuary issues etc be presented at the same time.
