A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, APPROVING A ONE YEAR EXTENSION OF THE CONTRACT BETWEEN THE CITY AND CHARLEY TOPPINO AND SONS, INC. FOR PAVEMENT MARKINGS, STRIPING & ROADWAY SIGNAGE ON A TASK ORDER BASIS, IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE TERMS SPECIFIED IN ITB 20-007; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE NECESSARY DOCUMENTS UPON ADVICE AND CONSENT OF THE CITY ATTORNEY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, in Resolution No. 20-095 the City Commission awarded a contract to Charley Toppino & Sons, Inc. in response to ITB #20-007, for Pavement Marking, Striping and Roadway Signage; and

WHEREAS, staff recommends approval of a one-year extension, as referenced in the contract; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That a one-year extension of the contract between the City and Charley Toppino and Sons, Inc. for Pavement Markings, Striping and Roadway Signage, in accordance with the terms specified in ITB #20-007 is hereby approved.

Section 2: Task orders issued pursuant to the contract shall comply with the City's procurement guidelines.

Section 3: That the City Manager is authorized to execute documents pertaining to the contract extension upon the advice and consent of the City Attorney.

Section 4: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the Presiding Officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
