A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE MONROE COUNTY COMMERCIAL FISHERMEN, INC. TO CONDUCT THEIR ANNUAL FLORIDA KEYS SEAFOOD FESTIVAL AT BAYVIEW PARK ON SATURDAY, JANUARY 14, 2012 FROM 11:00 A.M. TO 8:00 P.M, PURSUANT TO TERMS AND CONDITIONS SET FORTH BY THE CITY MANAGER; AUTHORIZING THE SALE AND CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES WITHIN THE ENCLOSED AREA; GRANTING A SPECIAL EVENT PERMIT PURSUANT TO SECTION 6-86 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES FROM 11:00 A.M. TO 8:00 P.M; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the Monroe County Commercial Fishermen Inc. has pledged that a 100 percentage of the monies raised at this event will go toward three (3) scholarships to be awarded to the children of fishermen or his/her family who excel academically.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Commission of the City of Key West Florida;

SECTION 1. That the Monroe County Commercial Fishermen's, Inc is hereby granted permission to conduct a Seafood Festival on the day and during the hours stated above; PROVIDED that all trash is adequately collected and contained; that a guarantee indemnifying the city is executed; and that organization meets the terms and conditions set forth by the City Manager; and 25% of gross revenue or\$1,000.00, whichever is greater, shall be donated to the Monroe County Fishermen, Inc.

**SECTION 2.** That pursuant to Section 18-86 of the Key West Code of Ordinances, the Monroe County Commercial Fishermen, Inc. is hereby granted permission allowing the sale and consumption of alcoholic beverages within the enclosed area.

**SECTION 3.** That the Monroe County Fishermen, Inc will adhere to the recycling plan of the City of Key West, the one (1) recycling container for every one (1) trash barrels will be used and that they will be placed side by side.

**SECTION 4.** That the Monroe County Fishermen, Inc. is hereby granted a Special Event Permit under Section 6-86 of the Key West of Ordinances for an event that will take place and time herein described.
