#### **Narrative**

NARRATIVE OF INCIDENT

See Report Narrative for Ofc. Betz:

On 3/21/2025, at approximately 1531 hours, I (Ofc Betz) responded to 245 Front St, The Opal Resort and Marina, in reference to an intoxicated subject who was previously asked to leave the property.

On arrival, I was met by the security officer, Eric "Jake" Foor, who directed me to the rear of the property, near the bow of the cruise ship. As we made are way to the rear, Jake told me the subject has been coming onto the property and getting drunk over the past several days. Jake informed me that on one occasion, when he told him to leave, he became aggressive, so he decided to call the police. Jake added that the subject was given a trespass warning by manager, Alex Halpern.

I met with the subject, later identified as Ryan Donohue and explained to him why I was speaking to him. I explained that I was investigating criminal trespassing and that he was not free to leave at this time. I asked Donohue for his license/identification card. Donohue said he did not have one. I asked Donohue for his name and date of birth, which he provided.

I ran Donohue over KWPD communications channel 2 with the information he provided. They advised he had several active warrants, but no identification out of New York. I began to verify the information Donohue provided me. I asked Donohue to verify the spelling of his name. Donohue spelled his first name, but then stood. I walked over to reach for Donohue's arm, at which point he pulled away from me. I removed my Taser and told Donohue to turn around and place his hands behind his back. Donohue failed to comply. I repeated my commands numerous times and advised him he was under arrest. Donohue still failed to comply.

Donohue then tried to flee the area by running east over the bridge to Mallory Square. I deployed my Taser probes toward Donohue with only one striking him in the right side/leg. Donohue continued to run over the bridge toward Mallory Square. Jack also gave chase and got in front of me, preventing me from taking an additional deployment of my Taser. I yelled to Jack to "move out of the way". As Jack moved over, Donohue stumbled. As Donohue began to regain his footing, I deployed my Taser probes, which struck him in the back area with both probes. Donohue experienced full NMI and collapsed to the ground. I pinned Donohue to the ground with my knee and started to pull his right arm our from under him. Ofc Ham immediately arrived as I pinned him down and tried to take control of his left arm. Donohue tried to defeat our efforts by holding his arms underneath him. Ofc Ham and I were able to remove Donohue's arms and I was able to place him into handcuffs.

Ofc Howell and PO Harris arrived on scene. Ofc Howell, Ofc Harris, Ofc Ham and I walked Donohue back to the top of the bridge and we leaned Donohue onto a flatbed cart. Once Ofc Harris, Ofc Ham and Ofc Howell had control of him, I retrieved Donohue's back pack. I conducted a search incident to arrest of his back pack. During the search, I located Donohue's wallet, which contained his New York ID card (#846420440). Next to his ID card was a small baggie of a white powdery substance, believed to be cocaine.

During the search of the backpack, I could here Ofc Howell tell Donohue to relax and stop fighting. Donohue continued to scream profanities of Ofc Howell and Ham. Sgt Stutz and Sgt Malshiemer arrived on scene.

Ofc Roman and PO Lashley arrived with a patrol car. Donohue was placed into th patrol car and transported to LKMC for medical clearance.

I returned to the KWPD Bike Unit substation where I field tested the suspected cocaine. The powder field tested positive for cocaine. I weighed the substance. The substance weighed 0.1 grams (in its baggie). I placed the cocaine into evidence.

I had KWPD conduct a Criminal History on Donohue. Donohue showed a conviction (Guilty Plea) for Felony Flee and Elude in January 2020 and was sentenced to 9 months to 1 year and 11 months. I contacted MCDC records to check if Donohue had registered as a convicted felon in Monroe County, since he had been here over 48 hours, as stated by the Opal Security. MCDC advised Donohue had failed to register as a convicted Felon, in violation of 775.13.

There is BWC for this case.

Since Donohue did enter and remain on the property of the Opal Key Resort and Marina after being told to leave and not return by the management, Donohue was in violation of FSS 810.09-1a1.

Since Donohue did possess 0.1 grams of FTP cocaine, Donohue was in violation of FSS 893.113-6a.



### **Investigation Details**

Since Donohue did attempt to overcome my efforts to lawfully place him under arrest by running from me, then by pulling his arms underneath himself as we tried to handcuff him, Donohue was in violation of 843.02.

Since Donohue did fail to register with Monroe County Sheriff's Office as a convicted felon prior to being in the county for over 48 hours and after being released from prison, probation or parole within the last five years, Donohue was in violation of FSS 775.13

See Supplemental Narrative for Ofc. Howell:

On Friday, 03/21/2025 at approximately 1529 hours, Probationary Ofc. Harris and I (Ofc. Howell) self-initiated back up for Ofc. Betz near 245 Front Street (Opel Key Resort and Marina) regarding a suspicious person possibly trespassing on the property.

As Probationary Ofc. Harris and I arrived to the scene, parking within the parking area of the marina, approximately a block away from Ofc. Betz's location. I realized that Ofc. Betz reported, over the radio, that he had the unknown male subject at taser point. Eventually Ofc. Betz conveyed, over the radio, that the unknown male subject was actively running away in an attempt to escape. As I ran to the scene, approaching Ofc. Betz's new location, Ofc. Betz and Ofc. Ham had an unknown white male subject in handcuffs. Ofc. Betz had deployed his taser at least once at this point. The unknown male subject was yelling and screaming obscenities toward all officers on scene. After checking on Ofc. Betz and Ofc. Ham, I assisted Ofc. Ham as he lifted the unknown male subject to his feet in an attempt to walk him to our patrol vehicles. The unknown male subject immediately began actively and repeatedly attempting to pull away while tensing up his arms and legs. The unknown male subject repeatedly attempted to pull his arms from our grasps. Enroute to the patrol vehicles, Ofc. Betz and I realized a maintenance worker for the marina was driving by in a golf cart with an open utility bed on the back. Ofc. Betz flagged down the maintenance worker and inquired if we could place the unknown male subject in the back of the golf cart and transport him to the patrol vehicles parked approximately a block away. As Ham and I attempted to place the unknown male subject in the bed of the golf cart he continuously screamed obscenities while thrashing his head and kicking his legs and feet. The unknown male subject continued to attempt to pull away throughout the encounter. At one point, the unknown male subject looked up at me and stated that he was planning to spit in my face, at which point, due to the unknown male subject erratic and aggressive behavior I instinctually pushed his upper torso down and away from me into the bed of the golf cart. The unknown male subject, still attempting to pull away, struck the bed of the golf cart face-first, striking his mouth. Due to the unknown male subject behavior, he sustained lacerations on his lips causing a small amount of blood to pool in the bed of the golf cart. Eventually, as more backup officers arrived to the scene, Ofc. Pettee and Probationary Ofc. Harris returned to my patrol vehicle and navigated back to our location. Ofc. Lashley and I searched the unknown male subject's person to the best of our abilities as the he continuously attempted to pull away while placing him in my patrol vehicle. Ofc. Betz and Probationary Ofc. Harris searched the unknown male subject's belongings. At some point, Ofc. Betz discovered a small clear plastic baggy with a white powdery substance.

The unknown white male subject was later identified by his New York identification card as Ryan M. Donohue (DOB: 04/25/1988, Arrestee).

Due to his actions, Donohue sustained three small abrasions on his right knee that where approximately one inch in width and length. Donohue also sustained at least two small lacerations to his back from Ofc. Betz's taser probes as well as the small lacerations to his upper and lower lips.

Probationary Ofc. Harris and I transported Donohue to Lower Keys Medical Center Emergency Room for medical attention and clearance for Monroe County Detention Center. Donohue was treated and medically cleared by Dr. Gandia and his emergency room staff. Probationary Ofc. Harris and I transported Donohue to Monroe County Detention Center.

My BWC was activated for the encounter, arrest, and subsequent search of Donohue and his belongings. My FLEET AXON was activated for the transport of Donohue to Lower Keys Medical Center Emergency Room and Monroe County Detention Center. I uploaded the videos to Evidence.com.

At this time, no further information.

See Supplemental Narrative for Ofc. Ham:

On March 21, 2025, at approximately 1531 hours, I, Ofc. S. Ham was dispatched to 245 Front St., reference a trespasser.

Upon arrival, Ofc. F. Betz was on scene, and I was unable to locate. Key West Police dispatch advised that Ofc. Betz had the suspect at taser point near the bow of the ship. As I made my way around the corner of the building, a few passersby stated that the suspect was beginning to get unruly. I started to run towards Ofc. Betz and the suspect began to flee from Ofc. Betz. I continued running behind, following Ofc. Betz and the suspect. I saw Ofc. Betz fire of one taser round, striking the suspect in the back with a single probe. The suspect continued running towards Mallory Square, when he fell. The suspect attempted to get up and Ofc. Betz fired the second set of taser prongs, striking the suspect and obtaining NMI (Neuromuscular Incapacitation). The suspect was laying on his left arm. I advised the suspect to lay on his stomach while Ofc. Betz advised to the suspect to put his hands behind his back. I grabbed the suspects left arm by his jacket sleeve and began trying to pull it

from underneath him. The suspect stated he could not put his harms behind his back but was physically pulling it back underneath himself as I was trying to remove it. I removed the suspects left arm and maintained control for Ofc. Betz to handcuff the suspect. Ofc. Betz and I sat the suspect up. Ofc. Howell arrived on scene with Ofc. Harris and they assisted Ofc. Betz with escorting the suspect back over the bridge.

While walking behind them escorting the suspect, I spotted one taser prong dragging on the ground behind Ofc. Betz, that I retrieved. The suspect was stood behind a golf cart to wait for transport. I took over the suspects right arm from Ofc. Betz because the suspect was pulling away while Ofc. Betz began his search incident to arrest. While maintaining control of the suspects right arm, using joint manipulation of his wrist he continued to tense and pull from Ofc. Howell and me. I located a dangling taser probe near the suspects wrist, that I removed and handed to Ofc. V. Roman. Ofc. Howell had control of the suspects upper left half and had a hand near another taser probe that had come loose from the suspects` skin. The taser was near the upper portion of the suspects back in the center stuck in his jacket. I removed that probe and handed it to Ofc. Roman. The suspect had one final probe near his ribcage on his right side.

Sgt. Malsheimer advised Ofc. Howell and I to place the suspect in the backseat of a patrol vehicle. The final probe was dislodged from the suspects ribcage and was solely in his jacket material. I removed the probe and handed it to Ofc. Roman. I searched the suspect prior to placing him in the backseat of the patrol vehicle. Ofc. Howell and I sat the suspect into the patrol car as he refused to place his feet inside the car. I lifted the suspects feet into the car and closed the door.

I packaged the taser cartridge and submitted it into the Key West Police Department property and evidence.

My Axon BWC was activated and uploaded.

#### -- Ryan Michael Donohue Arrest Narrative:

On 3/21/2025, at approximately 1531 hours, I (Ofc Betz) responded to 245 Front St, The Opal Resort and Marina, in reference to an intoxicated subject who was previously asked to leave the property.

On arrival, I was met by the security officer, Eric "Jake" Foor, who directed me to the rear of the property, near the bow of the cruise ship. As we made are way to the rear, Jake told me the subject has been coming onto the property and getting drunk over the past several days. Jake informed me that on one occasion, when he told him to leave, he became aggressive, so he decided to call the police. Jake added that the subject was given a trespass warning by manager, Alex Halpern.

I met with the subject, later identified as Ryan Donohue and explained to him why I was speaking to him. I explained that I was investigating criminal trespassing and that he was not free to leave at this time. I asked Donohue for his license/identification card. Donohue said he did not have one. I asked Donohue for his name and date of birth, which he provided.

I ran Donohue over KWPD communications channel 2 with the information he provided. They advised he had several active warrants, but no identification out of New York. I began to verify the information Donohue provided me. I asked Donohue to verify the spelling of his name. Donohue spelled his first name, but then stood. I walked over to reach for Donohue's arm, at which point he pulled away from me. I removed my Taser and told Donohue to turn around and place his hands behind his back. Donohue failed to comply. I repeated my commands numerous times and advised him he was under arrest. Donohue still failed to comply.

Donohue then tried to flee the area by running east over the bridge to Mallory Square. I deployed my Taser probes toward Donohue with only one striking him in the right side/leg. Donohue continued to run over the bridge toward Mallory Square. Jack also gave chase and got in front of me, preventing me from taking an additional deployment of my Taser. I yelled to Jack to "move out of the way". As Jack moved over, Donohue stumbled. As Donohue began to regain his footing, I deployed my Taser probes, which struck him in the back area with both probes. Donohue experienced full NMI and collapsed to the ground. I pinned Donohue to the ground with my knee and started to pull his right arm our from under him. Ofc Ham immediately arrived as I pinned him down and tried to take control of his left arm. Donohue tried to defeat our efforts by holding his arms underneath him. Ofc Ham and I were able to remove Donohue's arms and I was able to place him into handcuffs.

Ofc Howell and PO Harris arrived on scene. Ofc Howell, Ofc Harris, Ofc Ham and I walked Donohue back to the top of the bridge and we leaned Donohue onto a flatbed cart. Once Ofc Harris, Ofc Ham and Ofc Howell had control of him, I retrieved Donohue's back pack. I conducted a search incident to arrest of his back pack. During the search, I located Donohue's wallet, which contained his New York ID card (#846420440). Next to his ID card was a small baggie of a white powdery substance, believed to be cocaine.

During the search of the backpack, I could here Ofc Howell tell Donohue to relax and stop fighting. Donohue continued to scream profanities of Ofc Howell and Ham. Sgt Stutz and Sgt Malshiemer arrived on scene.

Ofc Roman and PO Lashley arrived with a patrol car. Donohue was placed into the patrol car and transported to LKMC for medical clearance.

I returned to the KWPD Bike Unit substation where I field tested the suspected cocaine. The powder field tested

positive for cocaine. I weighed the substance. The substance weighed 0.1 grams (in its baggie). I placed the cocaine into evidence.

I had KWPD conduct a Criminal History on Donohue. Donohue showed a conviction (Guilty Plea) for Felony Flee and Elude in January 2020 and was sentenced to 9 months to 1 year and 11 months. I contacted MCDC records to check if Donohue had registered as a convicted felon in Monroe County, since he had been here over 48 hours, as stated by the Opal Security. MCDC advised Donohue had failed to register as a convicted Felon, in violation of 775.13.

There is BWC for this case.

Since Donohue did enter and remain on the property of the Opal Key Resort and Marina after being told to leave and not return by the management, Donohue was in violation of FSS 810.09-1a1.

Since Donohue did possess 0.1 grams of FTP cocaine, Donohue was in violation of FSS 893.113-6a.

Since Donohue did attempt to overcome my efforts to lawfully place him under arrest by running from me, then by pulling his arms underneath himself as we tried to handcuff him, Donohue was in violation of 843.02.

Since Donohue did fail to register with Monroe County Sheriff's Office as a convicted felon prior to being in the county for over 48 hours and after being released from prison, probation or parole within the last five years, Donohue was in violation of FSS 775.13

On Friday, 03/21/2025 at approximately 1529 hours, Probationary Ofc. Harris and I (Ofc. Howell) self-initiated back up for Ofc. Betz near 245 Front Street (Opel Key Resort and Marina) regarding a suspicious person possibly trespassing on the property.

As Probationary Ofc. Harris and I arrived to the scene, parking within the parking area of the marina, approximately a block away from Ofc. Betz's location, I realized that Ofc. Betz reported, over the radio, that he had the unknown male subject at taser point. Eventually Ofc. Betz conveyed, over the radio, that the unknown male subject was actively running away in an attempt to escape. As I ran to the scene, approaching Ofc. Betz's new location, Ofc. Betz and Ofc. Ham had an unknown white male subject in handcuffs. Ofc. Betz had deployed his taser at least once at this point. The unknown male subject was yelling and screaming obscenities toward all officers on scene. After checking on Ofc. Betz and Ofc. Ham, I assisted Ofc. Ham as he lifted the unknown male subject to his feet in an attempt to walk him to our patrol vehicles. The unknown male subject immediately began actively and repeatedly attempting to pull away while tensing up his arms and legs. The unknown male subject repeatedly attempted to pull his arms from our grasps. Enroute to the patrol vehicles, Ofc. Betz and I realized a maintenance worker for the marina was driving by in a golf cart with an open utility bed on the back. Ofc. Betz flagged down the maintenance worker and inquired if we could place the unknown male subject in the back of the golf cart and transport him to the patrol vehicles parked approximately a block away. As Ham and I attempted to place the unknown male subject in the bed of the golf cart he continuously screamed obscenities while thrashing his head and kicking his legs and feet. The unknown male subject continued to attempt to pull away throughout the encounter. At one point, the unknown male subject looked up at me and stated that he was planning to spit in my face, at which point, due to the unknown male subject erratic and aggressive behavior I instinctually pushed his upper torso down and away from me into the bed of the golf cart. The unknown male subject, still attempting to pull away, struck the bed of the golf cart face-first, striking his mouth. Due to the unknown male subject behavior, he sustained lacerations on his lips causing a small amount of blood to pool in the bed of the golf cart. Eventually, as more backup officers arrived to the scene, Ofc. Pettee and Probationary Ofc. Harris returned to my patrol vehicle and navigated back to our location. Ofc. Lashley and I searched the unknown male subject's person to the best of our abilities as the he continuously attempted to pull away while placing him in my patrol vehicle. Ofc. Betz and Probationary Ofc. Harris searched the unknown male subject's belongings. At some point, Ofc. Betz discovered a small clear plastic baggy with a white powdery substance.

The unknown white male subject was later identified by his New York identification card as Ryan M. Donohue (DOB: 04/25/1988, Arrestee).

Due to his actions, Donohue sustained three small abrasions on his right knee that where approximately one inch in width and length. Donohue also sustained at least two small lacerations to his back from Ofc. Betz's taser probes as

well as the small lacerations to his upper and lower lips.

Probationary Ofc. Harris and I transported Donohue to Lower Keys Medical Center Emergency Room for medical attention and clearance for Monroe County Detention Center. Donohue was treated and medically cleared by Dr. Gandia and his emergency room staff. Probationary Ofc. Harris and I transported Donohue to Monroe County Detention Center.

My BWC was activated for the encounter, arrest, and subsequent search of Donohue and his belongings. My FLEET AXON was activated for the transport of Donohue to Lower Keys Medical Center Emergency Room and Monroe County Detention Center. I uploaded the videos to Evidence.com.

On March 21, 2025, at approximately 1531 hours, I, Ofc. S. Ham was dispatched to 245 Front St., reference a trespasser.

Upon arrival, Ofc. F. Betz was on scene, and I was unable to locate. Key West Police dispatch advised that Ofc. Betz had the suspect at taser point near the bow of the ship. As I made my way around the corner of the building, a few passersby stated that the suspect was beginning to get unruly. I started to run towards Ofc. Betz and the suspect began to flee from Ofc. Betz. I continued running behind, following Ofc. Betz and the suspect. I saw Ofc. Betz fire of one taser round, striking the suspect in the back with a single probe. The suspect continued running towards Mallory Square, when he fell. The suspect attempted to get up and Ofc. Betz fired the second set of taser prongs, striking the suspect and obtaining NMI (Neuromuscular Incapacitation). The suspect was laying on his left arm. I advised the suspect to lay on his stomach while Ofc. Betz advised to the suspect to put his hands behind his back. I grabbed the suspects left arm by his jacket sleeve and began trying to pull it from underneath him. The suspect stated he could not put his harms behind his back but was physically pulling it back underneath himself as I was trying to remove it. I removed the suspects left arm and maintained control for Ofc. Betz to handcuff the suspect. Ofc. Betz and I sat the suspect up. Ofc. Howell arrived on scene with Ofc. Harris and they assisted Ofc. Betz with escorting the suspect back over the bridge.

While walking behind them escorting the suspect, I spotted one taser prong dragging on the ground behind Ofc. Betz, that I retrieved. The suspect was stood behind a golf cart to wait for transport. I took over the suspects right arm from Ofc. Betz because the suspect was pulling away while Ofc. Betz began his search incident to arrest. While maintaining control of the suspects right arm, using joint manipulation of his wrist he continued to tense and pull from Ofc. Howell and me. I located a dangling taser probe near the suspects wrist, that I removed and handed to Ofc. V. Roman. Ofc. Howell had control of the suspects upper left half and had a hand near another taser probe that had come loose from the suspects' skin. The taser was near the upper portion of the suspects back in the center stuck in his jacket. I removed that probe and handed it to Ofc. Roman. The suspect had one final probe near his ribcage on his right side.

Sgt. Malsheimer advised Ofc. Howell and I to place the suspect in the backseat of a patrol vehicle. The final probe was dislodged from the suspects ribcage and was solely in his jacket material. I removed the probe and handed it to Ofc. Roman. I searched the suspect prior to placing him in the backseat of the patrol vehicle. Ofc. Howell and I sat the suspect into the patrol car as he refused to place his feet inside the car. I lifted the suspects feet into the car and closed the door.

I packaged the taser cartridge and submitted it into the Key West Police Department property and evidence.
