





## Bids Broadcast, Opened, Awarded and Closed-

In the month of March, the Office of Procurement issued two bid documents for upcoming City projects. The first bid document, related to the establishment of a Water Quality Monitoring Program, was broadcast on March 20, 2025, at 8:00 AM, with a bid due date of April 17, 2025. The second bid document, issued on March 22, 2025, sought contractors for the Piling Replacement, H2 Dock Extension, and Cantilever Walkway Repair at the Key West Bight, with a bid due date of April 30, 2025.

Additionally, one bid was opened in March by the Clerk's Office in response to the Invitation to Bid (ITB) for the Schooner Wharf Floating Docks Replacement. Three bids were received for this project, with Gemstone RDI, JV LLC recommended for award. However, following the City Commission meeting in April, all bids were rejected, and the procurement process for this project will be re-advertised.

In terms of contract awards during March, the City Commission approved several agreements. In response to ITB 25-006, one bid was received for the painting of the Police and Fire Station, with a contract value not to exceed \$80,000. This contract was awarded to Five 12 Painting & Remodeling, LLC. Additionally, the City Commission approved the agreement for Standby Feeding Services, stemming from RFP 24-010, which was awarded to The Star of the Sea Foundation (S.O.S.), Inc.

## **Additional Information-**

The City Commission has authorized City Staff to review the proposal submitted by Fortress Security for the construction of Fire Station #3 under the Public-Private Partnership Business Model. This unsolicited proposal is currently under evaluation by City Staff to determine whether it qualifies as a viable project for the City's consideration, initial meeting to review the proposal submitted is scheduled for April 11, 2025.
