RE: 1232 South Street

A site inspection was done on December 20, 2011, and documented the following:

The tree is a Gumbo Limbo tree (*Bursea simaruba*).

Circumference: 72" = 22.93" dbh

Location: 80% (No apparent utility line, fence or foundation issues.)

Species: 100% (on the protected tree list)

Condition: 70% (Overall health of tree appears to be ok. Can see some areas of sap buildup and drainage from tree indicating that there may be a health issue with the tree but the canopy appears to be mostly intact.)

NOTE: the tree does have white fly but this did not influence the condition value.

Total Average Value = 83%

Value x Diameter=replacement caliper (dbh) inches = .83 x 22.93 " = **19" replacement**
