A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, APPROVING ATTACHED "INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT" PURSUANT CHAPTER 163, TO FLORIDA STATUTES, BETWEEN THE FLORIDA AQUEDUCT AUTHORITY AND THE CITY OF KEY WEST FOR ASPHALT PAVING OF NEWTON STREET BETWEEN WHITE STREET AND EISENHOWER DRIVE; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of Key West is seeking to partner with the Florida Keys Aqueduct authority, who has improvement projects on or below Newton Street, requiring the partial repaving of Newton Street; and

WHEREAS, an Interlocal Agreement between the two governmental agencies is the most efficient method to repave the entirety of Newton Street between White Street and Eisenhower Drive; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the attached "Interlocal Agreement Pursuant to Chapter 163, Florida Statutes for improvements to Newton Street between the City of Key West and the Florida Keys Aqueduct Authority is hereby approved.

Section 2: That the City will reimburse Florida Keys Aqueduct Authority 50% of the cost of the additional repaving on Newton Street, as described in the attached work order.

Section 3: That the Interim City Manager is authorized to execute documents related to this work order and Interlocal Agreement, upon the advice and consent of the City Attorney.

Section 4: That funds for reimbursement are allocated in account #102-4102-541-6300 project II4102401.

Section 5: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the Presiding Officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
