CHAPTER 57-1470

SENATE BILL NO. 736

AN ACT abolishing the existing board of commissioners of the Key West housing authority; creating a new board of commissioners of the Key West housing authority; and providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. The existing board of commissioners of the Key West housing authority is hereby abolished, and the membership thereof is hereby terminated effective at 12:00 o'clock noon, on the first Tuesday after the fourth Monday in November, 1957.

Section 2. There is hereby created a new board of commissioners of the Key West housing authority to be composed of five (5) members, who shall be appointed by the mayor of the City of Key West for terms of four (4) years. Vacancies in the said board shall be filled as provided for the original appointments for the balance of the term of the membership vacated.

Section 3. The board of commissioners of the Key West housing authority now existent shall immediately upon the appointment of the board of commissioners of the Key West housing authority created by this act, turn over all papers, records, monies, and other property belonging to the Key West housing authority to the said board.

Section 4. The board of commissioners of the Key West housing authority created by this act shall be vested with all the powers and authorities and shall administer the affairs of the housing authority in all respects as though created by virtue of section 421.05, Florida Statutes, and shall be subject to all the provisions of chapter 421, Florida Statutes, or other law relating to municipal housing authorities in this state.

Section 5. This act shall take effect immediately upon becoming a law.

Became a law without the Governor's approval.
