Proposed Ordinance Title/Reference:

Amendment to City of Key West Code of Ordinances - Special Events Sec. 6-26. through Sec. 6-115

The Proposed Ordinance **does** **does not fall under one of the following enumerated exceptions:**

 - b. Comprehensive plan amendments and land development regulation amendments initiated by an application by a private party other than the county;
 - c. Sections 190.005 and 190.046, Florida Statutes, regarding community development districts;
 - d. Section 553.73, Florida Statutes, relating to the Florida Building Code; or
 - e. Section 633.202, Florida Statutes, relating to the Florida Fire Prevention Code.

Summary of Proposed Ordinance and Statement of Public Purpose to be Served:

The purpose is to update and better define special event processes and requirements and consolidate city code specific to special events into a central location within the city code for greater clarity.
