Subject: Monthly Report - February, 2025

In February 2025, the Key West Police Department's Communication Center received 5,232 calls into the dispatch center. Of those calls, 1,552 came directly to 911. Those calls generated 2,077 calls for service for police/fire/rescue. Compared to February 2024, we experienced an 10.9% decrease in 911 calls, a 7.9% increase in non-emergency calls, and an 10.2% decrease in calls for service for police/fire/rescue.

Officers completed 528 police reports and 135 arrests were made. Compared to February 2024, police reports decreased by 10.5% and arrests increased by 35%.

A total of 693 traffic stops (including e-bikes, stand-up scooters, bicycles, golf carts) were conducted. We issued 177 citations and 152 written warnings.
