

RESOLUTION NO.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA HEREBY APPROVING A NEW DOCKAGE LICENSE AGREEMENT, AS ATTACHED HERETO AND MADE A PART HEREOF, FOR COMMERCIAL TENANTS ON CHARTER BOAT ROW AT GARRISON BIGHT MARINA; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE NECESSARY RELATED DOCUMENTS AND BUDGET TRANSFERS/AMENDMENTS, UPON CONSENT OF THE CITY ATTORNEY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the current Charter Boat Row dockage agreement for commercial tenants on Charter Boat Row at Garrison Bight Marina expires March 31, 2026; and

WHEREAS, the proposed dockage license agreement, as attached hereto and made a part hereof, includes input from the leadership of the Key West Charter Boat Association;

WHEREAS, no procurement is required for the City to adopt a new dockage license agreement and rates will rise annually via the average change in the U.S. Department of Commerce Consumer Price Index (CPI) for All Urban Consumers, as reported by the Bureau of Labor Statistics for the twelve (12) months prior to the renewal date; and

WHEREAS, rate increases above CPI may be approved by the City Commission during annual budget approvals; and

WHEREAS, staff recommends the Mayor and City Commission approve the proposed dockage license agreement for commercial tenants of Charter Boat Row at the City Marina at Garrison Bight;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF
THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the City Commission hereby approves the proposed Charter Boat Row Dockage License Agreement, as attached hereto and made a part hereof, for commercial tenants on Charter Boat Row at Garrison Bight Marina.

Section 2. That the City Commission hereby authorizes the City Manager to execute any necessary related documents and budget transfers/amendments, upon the advice and consent of the City Attorney.

Section 3. That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signatures of the presiding officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
