A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING A \$3,000.00 DONATION FROM THE LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS TRUST FUND (STATE FORFEITURE FUNDS), PURSUANT TO FLORIDA STATUTES SECTION 932.7055, TO THE MONROE COUNTY SCHOOL DISTRICT - PRE-K IN THE KEYS PROGRAM; AUTHORIZING ANY NECESSARY BUDGET TRANSFER OR ADJUSTMENT; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, The Monroe County School District Pre-K in the Keys Program's goal is to strengthen the connection between home, school, police, and community while promoting school readiness, by providing custom board games to every family registering a child for kindergarten; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That pursuant to Florida Statutes section 932.7055, a \$3,000.00 donation is hereby authorized by the City Commission from the Law Enforcement Officers Trust Fund (state forfeiture funds) for use by the Monroe County School District Pre-K in the Keys Program for the purposes expressly authorized by that statutory section.

Section 2: That funding for this expenditure is available in the State Law Enforcement Officers Trust Fund Account No. 172-2111-521-8200. Any necessary budget transfers or adjustments are hereby authorized.

Section 3: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the Presiding Officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
