A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AWARDING THE BID OF DOUGLAS N. HIGGINS, INC., IN RESPONSE TO ITB 20-001 FOR THE DEEP WELL INJECTION PUMP AND HVAC PROJECT AT THE RICHARD A. HEYMAN ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION FACILITY IN THE AMOUNT OF \$827,000.00; AUTHORIZING NECESSARY BUDGET ADJUSTMENTS AND TRANSFERS; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT IN CONFORMANCE WITH THE BID DOCUMENTS UPON CONSENT OF THE CITY ATTORNEY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, on February 26, 2020, one bid was received for ITB 20-001, Deep Well Injection Pump and HVAC Project at the Richard A. Heyman Environmental Protection Facility; and

WHEREAS, the bid of Douglas N. Higgins, Inc. was the sole responsive and responsible bid, and City staff recommends award of the bid accordingly; and

WHEREAS, the project has been identified as a priority, and accordingly, budget transfers and adjustments to meet a budget shortfall will be met by shelving a budgeted project for Sludge Conveyor, and transferring allocated funds from that project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the bid of Douglas N. Higgins, Inc. in the amount of \$827,000.00 is hereby awarded, in response to ITB 20-001 for the Deep Well Injection Pump and HVAC Project at the Richard Heyman Environmental Protection Facility.

Section 2: That funding for the project is budgeted in Utilities/Sewer/WWTP/CIP 401-3504-535-6500 Project SE35041902. Prior components of the overall project cost \$755,818.00, leaving a balance of \$444,182.00 in the project budget. Budget transfers and adjustments are hereby authorized to meet the budget shortfall of \$382,818.00 by shelving a budgeted project SE35041903 (sludge conveyor) and transferring allocated funds from that project to SE35041902 account 401-3504-535-6500.

Section 3: That the City Manager is authorized to enter into a contract in conformity with the bid documents upon the consent of the City Attorney.

Section 4: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the Presiding Officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
