A RESOLUTION OF THE CAROLINE STREET CORRIDOR AND BAHAMA VILLAGE COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY (CRA) APPROVING THE ATTACHED LEASE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CRA AND THE MEL FISHER MARITIME HERITAGE SOCIETY, INC. FOR THE "TURTLE CANNERY BUILDING" IN THE HISTORIC SEAPORT; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, in Resolution No. 19-277, the CRA approved a Lease with the Mel Fisher Maritime Heritage Society operating the Turtle Museum at the Historic Seaport; and

WHEREAS, in Resolution No. KWBB 24-15, the Key West Bight Management District Board recommended approval of a First Amendment to Lease Agreement between the CRA and the Mel Fisher Maritime Heritage Society, to extend the Lease for up to five years, upon certain terms and conditions; and

WHEREAS, the CRA finds that the Lessee provides a valuable public benefit and is otherwise consistent with City Code of Ordinances section 2-941(c), supporting a below-market rental rate.
