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On July 8, 2022, at approximately 1730 hours, I, Ofc. S. Ham was dispatched to 420 Applerouth Ln, reference a verbal altercation.

Upon arrival, employees at Virgilios (524 Duval St) pointed out the suspect, later identified as Aaron Ames. I approached Aaron and asked him to have a seat because he was waving his arms around and yelling. Aaron refused to have a seat and began to walk west on Applerouth Ln away from me. I stopped Aaron by placing my arm on his chest and asked him again to have a seat. Aaron refused by saying he was not going to sit and attempted to walk away again. I grabbed ahold of Aaron's left arm and guided him to the corner to have a seat. I asked Aaron what was going on and he stated nothing. I asked Aaron where he was from, and he stated Rhode Island. Aaron stood up from the and refused to have sit back down. Aaron requested to sit across the street. I walked with Aaron across the street to sit in the shade. Aaron refused to sit down and tried walking away. Aaron asked if he was free to leave and I explained to him that he was not while I was conducting the investigation. Aaron walked past me and began to go east on Applerouth Ln. I attempted to grab ahold of Aaron by his left arm while I told him to stop. Aaron pulled his arm away from my grasp and tried to begin to run. Aaron was sweating profusely making it hard to gain a grasp on Aaron by his arm. I made multiple attempts to stop Aaron until I got two hands on Aarons left arm. I performed a modified straight arm take down to redirect Aaron towards the ground. I handcuffed Aaron as my back-up officer (Ofc. G. Medina) arrived.

Ofc. Medina and I rolled Aaron into a recovery position and Aaron continued yelling nonsense. Aaron appeared to be under the influence of some sort of narcotics. Aaron continued rolling onto his stomach. Ofc. Medina and I attempted to place Aaron in the recovery position again and Aaron bent his knee upwards towards his chest and attempted to kick them out at us. I grabbed ahold of Aaron's legs and restrained them on the ground while Ofc. Medina obtained a hobble. Ofc. Medina and I applied the hobble to Aaron's ankles.

A small crowd began to gather as they could hear Aaron yelling. A family with kids were across the street and a young boy asked his dad to assist us while we were controlling Aaron.

Ofc. Medina and I searched Aaron's person for a form of identification incident to arrest. Inside of Aaron's left front pocket Ofc. Medina located a small brown wooden box with a wood top that rotates, to uncover a compartment for a small metal pipe (one-hitter) and another compartment used to store marijuana. Inside of Aaron's front right pocket a cigarette pack was located and a hand rolled joint with a green leafy substance was located. Aaron's identification was located inside a stack of cards that were inside of his wallet that was in his back right pocket.

I spoke to the witness, later identified as Alexandr Tolmachenko, who stated he saw Aaron approach a male on the sidewalk and then walk across the street. Alexandr stated Aaron began swinging the two bicycles that were locked up to a cable and hitting them against each other. Alexandr stated Aaron then walked across the street and approached the male again, later identified as Jesse Levine. Alexandr stated Aaron approached Jesse in an aggressive manner and cornered him against the wall. Alexandr stated Jesse was telling Aaron to back up and stop coming at him, but Aaron just kept yelling. Alexandr stated Jesse hit Aaron with his bicycle chain and it didn't seem to phase Aaron. Alexandr stated Jesse was standing across the street and pointed him out to me.

I spoke with Jesse, and he stated he walked to his bicycle that was locked up and was approached by Aaron yelling and not making any sense. Jesse stated he told Aaron to stay away from him, but Aaron continued to get closer. Jesse stated he was not sure what was wrong with Aaron, but he appeared to be under the influence of drugs. Jesse stated Aaron then walked across the street and began slamming the two bicycles that were locked up to the cable.

Jesse stated Aaron began swinging on the cable and kicking the bicycles. Jesse stated he was about to lock his bicycle back up to the bicycle stand and Aaron approached him a second time. Jesse stated he told Aaron to stay back and to not get any closer. Jesse stated he was in fear that Aaron was going to harm him because the manner he was walking towards him. Jesse stated Aaron had him backed into a corner where he felt he couldn't get out and swung his bicycle lock chain at Aaron, striking him on the neck with it. Jesse stated it didn't seem to phase Aaron, but it made him walk away from him. Jesse stated he didn't know what Aaron could do because the state of mind that he was in. Jesse stated he wished to pursue charges for assault.

I spoke to Sgt. M. Siracuse and advised him of what happened.

I asked Alexandr if he could find me the owners of the two bicycles. I spoke to the owners of the bicycles that claimed their bicycles were damaged from Aaron but refused to pursue charges against him.

Key West Rescue personnel arrived on scene and transported Aaron to Lower Keys Medical Center due to his mental state. Ofc. L. Hernandez rode with Key West Rescue to LKMC.

I arrived at LKMC and spoke to rescue personnel that advised me they had to give Aaron ketamine to calm him down during transport and a second dose once they arrived in the ER.

I stood by and waited for Aaron's medical clearance. After Aaron was medically cleared from the ER, an ER nurse and attempted to get Aaron inside the backseat of my patrol vehicle. Aaron refused to get into the backseat and made his body limp, causing myself and the ER nurse to lift Aaron upwards and sit him down inside the backset. I transported Aaron to Monroe County Detention Center without further incident.

Aaron intentionally threatened to do harm towards Jesse by approaching him in an aggressive manner and backing him into a corner, creating a well-founded fear that violence was imminent. There is probable cause to believe that Aaron was in violation of F.S.S 784.011-1 Assault.

Aaron verbally refused to stay as I was conducting the investigation and then physically pulled away from me when I attempted to handcuff him, causing me to regain a grip on Aaron and performing a straight arm take down. Once Aaron was handcuffed and, on the ground, Aaron continued to pull away and lifted his feet in the air in an attempt to kick myself or Ofc. Medina. Aaron was placed in a hobble to control his legs. There is probable cause to believe Aaron was in violation of F.S.S. 843.01 Resisting with violence.

Aaron caused a scene by yelling on the 400 block of Applerouth Ln, hit and kicked two bicycles causing damage to them, and caused three separate people to call 911. Virgilios employees stopped business to stand outside their door and guard it to make sure Aaron did not enter. Aaron's yelling and screaming when I was on scene caused people to gather on the 400 block of Applerouth Ln, corrupting the public morals and affecting the peace and quiet. There is probable cause to believe Aaron was in violation of F.S.S. 877.03 Breach of the peace: Disorderly conduct.

Aaron was in possession of a small wooden container that was concealing a small white and orange metal pipe. Also inside the container was a small amount of a green leafy substance. The tip of the metal pipe was burnt and contained an ash like substance inside. Aaron was in violation of F.S.S. 893.147-1 Possession of drug paraphernalia.
