

Resolution #22-2604

**A Resolution of the Housing Authority
of the City of Key West, Florida,
Approving a Plan of Termination to
Phase Out Responsibilities of the Community Development Office
from the Housing Authority and Back to the City of Key West**

Whereas, on April 1, 1988, the City of Key West ("the City") and the Housing Authority of the City of Key West, Florida ("the Housing Authority") ("the Parties") entered into an Administrative Agreement, including a Management Plan, regarding the day-to-day operations of the Community Development Office ("the CDO"); and

Whereas, the Parties amended the Agreement and extended the term pursuant to a written agreement dated July 29, 2004, and on April 19, 2006, the Parties further amended the Agreement to include additional duties to be performed by the Housing Authority related to Workforce Housing Ordinance Enforcement; and

Whereas, those duties were previously the responsibility of the City's Planning Department; and

Whereas, on June 2, 2020, the Parties extended the term of the Agreement through September 30, 2024; and

Whereas, pursuant to Section V of the Agreement, should either of the Parties desire to terminate the Agreement prior to its expiration, the City and the Housing Authority shall develop a plan of termination period acceptable by both Parties and which will not be detrimental to either Party; and

Whereas, the intent of such plan would be to phase out responsibilities of the Agreement.

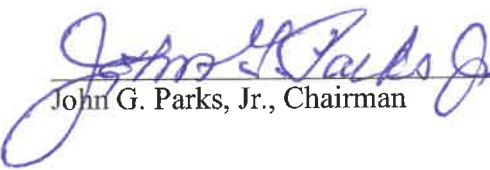
Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved, by the Board of Commissioners, authorizing staff to conduct negotiations with the City to develop a plan of termination to phase out responsibilities of the CDO from the Housing Authority and back to the City.
