-- Johnathan Kyle Streeter Arrest Narrative:

On Sunday, January 21, 2024 at approximately 0046 hours I, Ofc. J. Hesse, was on routine patrol in the area of 1800 N. Roosevelt Blvd, operating a marked patrol vehicle. While traveling eastbound in the left lane, I observed a yellow golf cart bearing the Florida tag MILE059, occupied by two males, traveling in the same direction in the right lane. As I prepared to pass the slower moving vehicle in the right lane, the driver suddenly crossed the painted dividing line between the lanes, into my path of travel. The unexpected action of the driver required me to execute an evasive maneuver and abruptly apply the brakes to avoid a collision.

I activated my overhead emergency lights and initiated a traffic stop that terminated in front of 1800 N. Roosevelt Blvd. I contacted the driver, later identified as Johnathan Streeter, identified myself as an officer and indicated the reason for stop due to the driving behavior I witnessed. Streeter said that he saw the headlights of my patrol vehicle in his rearview mirror but thought there was a greater distance between the vehicles, indicating he was attempting to merge lanes.

During the short interaction to that point, Streeter exhibited slurred speech and had the odor of an alcoholic beverage on his breath. He also exhibited glassy, watery, bloodshot eyes, dilated pupils, and his eyelids droopy and had a very tired appearance. I asked Streeter if he had any alcohol to drink that night and he stated he had one rum and coke.

Based on the driving behavior I observed and the indicators of impairment present, I had probable cause to arrest Streeter for the crimes of DUI and reckless driving. I asked Streeter if he would participate in field sobriety exercises, and he consented. I advised Streeter of his rights per Miranda, and he indicated he understood. While Streeter walked to a flat area free from obstructions or debris, I noted his gait to be slightly unstable and swayed.

Streeter was asked various questions about his alcohol and drug consumption on that night, as well as any medical issues that may adversely affect his ability to perform field sobriety exercises. At that time, Streeter made no statements of any conditions that would affect his balance or any other faculty.

I administered the following exercises:

HGN:

No resting nystagmus was noted. Equal tracking was present in both eyes. Pupils were equal, round, and reactive to light. During the exercise I observed the following:

Lack of smooth pursuit was present in both eyes.

Distinct and sustained nystagmus at maximum deviation was observed in both eyes.

Onset of nystagmus was observed prior to 45 degrees.

No NVGN was observed.

A total of 6/6 clues were observed.

Walk and Turn:

For this exercise, I explained and demonstrated the exercise to Streeter and he indicated he understood. During the exercise I observed the following:

Unable to maintain balance during instruction.

Stopped walking.

Missed heel to toe steps.

Stepped off-line.

Used arms for balance.

Made an improper turn.

A total of 6/8 clues were observed.

One Leg Stand:

For this exercise, I explained and demonstrated the exercise to Streeter and confirmed he understood the instructions. After demonstrating the exercise, I asked Streeter to begin and started a time on my wristwatch of 30 seconds. During the exercise I observed the following:

Swayed in a circular pattern.

Put his foot down.

Hopped.

Used arms for balance.

Counted to 25 at the conclusion of 30 seconds.

A total of 4/4 clues were observed.

Following the completion of the exercises I asked Streeter if he felt he was able to safely operate a motor vehicle and he stated he was. Due to the reckless driving observed, indicators of impairment present, and his performance in field sobriety exercises, I advised Streeter he was under arrest for DUI.

I applied handcuffs that were checked for proper fit and double locked. I asked for consent to search his person and he consented, no items of interest were located. Streeter was secured into my patrol vehicle with the seatbelt and advised of continued Axon recording in the vehicle.

A search of Streeters' vehicle was completed with no items of interest located. All items of value were transported with Streeter.

Streeter was transported to the MCSO jail where I conducted a 20-minute observation period followed by a breath alcohol test which showed a result of 0.134 and 0.134. Streeter was lodged at the jail on the charge of DUI and Reckless Driving. Streeter was issued UTC's for DUI (AIGHIZE; Judge Kelley 02/09/2024, 0900hrs), and Reckless Driving (AIGHIZE; Judge Kelley 02/09/2024, 0900hrs), and additionally cited for failure to drive within lane (AIGHJ0E).

During the incident, Ofc. Lopez interacted with the passenger, Ryan Reeves. Reeves was subsequently arrested by Ofc. Lopez for resisting arrest without violence, and possession of a controlled substance. See Ofc. Lopez's supplemental report for greater details.

On January 21, 2024, at approximately 0046 hours, I, Ofc. Lopez was requested by Ofc. Hesse to respond to a traffic stop. Ofc. Hesse conducted a traffic stop near the intersection of N. Roosevelt Boulevard and George Street.

I, Ofc. Lopez responded to the traffic stop shortly after. On arrival, Ofc. Hesse informed me that he was going to conduct a DUI investigation and he requested me to stay with a male seated on the front passenger seat of the golf cart. Ofc. Hesse and the driver of the vehicle walked towards the parking lot of Miami Subs, (1800 N. Roosevelts Boulevard).

While I was standing near the curb of the road, the male seated of the passenger seat began speaking to me about an incident he was involved the night before. This male was later identified with his Michigan driver's license as Ryan Reeve, (dob:01/16/1981). Ryan stated that he was intoxicated the night before and he believes that he was not treated fairly. Ryan asked why I was standing there, and I informed him that I was standing there because he was still seated on the golf cart. Ryan exited the golfcart and began stumbling on the sidewalk. Ryan had a difficulty standing on his feet and unable to stay still. Ryan noticed my last name tag, (Lopez) and he asked me if I speak Spanish and I told him that I do. Ryan told me that he speaks Spanish and then he demanded me to speak Spanish to him. Ofc. Andrade walked up towards us, and he recognized Ryan from an incident the night before.

Ryan began getting agitated and talking about how he owns a company worth millions of dollars. Ryan continued making statements on how much money he has. Ryan told me that I am not even from the United States, and he will have me deported. Ryan began walking back and forth on the sidewalk. I informed Ryan that he is currently detained, and he is not free to leave. I explained Ryan that he is a passenger of a vehicle that a traffic stop was conducted. Ryan was standing in front of me approximately 3-4 feet away and at one point he leaned his upper body forward towards me. I told Ryan to stop getting close to my face. Ryan took a few steps away from me and he continued walking back and forth over the sidewalk. Ryan then was using a cellphone and he appeared as if he was making a phone call. Ryan said he was calling his lawyer. Ryan at one point, walked up towards my direction and stood up approximately 3 feet away from me. Ryan proceeded by taking a step forward and then leaning his head forward. Ryan's upper body leaned forward towards my direction. I told Ryan not to get close to my face one more time. Ryan took a few steps away and he continued walking back and forth over the sidewalk.

Ryan was holding his cellphone with his right hand by his right ear, and it appeared as if he was making a phone call. Ryan walked up to my direction, and he used his right foot to take a step close to me. Ryan was approximately 2-3 steps away from me. Ryan took steps back and then he continued walking back and forth over the sidewalk. Ryan then walked back to my direction and when he was approximately 2-3 feet away from me, he used his left foot to take a step forward to my direction. Ryan took a few steps away from me again.

It appeared as if Ryan could not get someone to answer his phone call. Ryan then was standing directly in front of me

approximately 3 feet away from me. Ryan used his right hand to hold his phone and proceeded by extending his arm towards me as he was holding his phone. I told Ryan not to get close to my face. Ryan proceeded by using his left foot to take a step close to the right side of my body. Ryan then lowered his right hand down close to the right side of his body. In a matter of seconds, Ryan extended his right arm towards me. Ryan's right hand came approximately 8 inches close to my chin. I used my right hand to redirect Ryan's right hand and prevent it from keep getting close to my face. When I used my right hand to redirect Ryan's hand, his cellphone was knocked down to the ground. I proceeded by grabbing his left wrist, as I grabbed Ryan's hands, he immediately turned to the left side of his body. Ryan took one step away from me, and he extended his right leg as he was pulling away from me. While Ryan stepped away from me, I got a hold of his jacket in an attempt to escort him to the ground. I performed a modified straight arm/leg sweep takedown after his active resistance.

Once Ryan was laying down on his stomach, he proceeded by leaning his upper back in an attempt to get up. I told Ryan to stop resisting while I was trying to get the handcuffs on him. I placed my right hand near Ryan's right shoulder blade to prevent him from turning his body towards me. My body worn camera was knocked down to the ground during this incident. I placed handcuffs on Ryan, and he was escorted to my patrol vehicle.

It should be noted that during this incident I remained standing near the curb of the road and looking towards the parking lot. I was looking towards Ofc. Hesse's location. I did the best I could to get my attention towards Ofc. Hesse's location to prevent Ryan from getting more agitated due to his level of intoxication. Despite how extremely patient I was by remaining standing on my feet on the same spot, Ryan continued disregarding my instructions when told not to get close to my face.

This incident was recorded with my body worn camera, (3722) and Ofc. Hesse's front in-car Axon camera, (4305).

Incident to arrest lead to the discovery of a controlled substance. While I was searching Ryan, I located one light green round tablet and two broken up tables with the same light green color round tablets. These tablets were located in Ryan's left rear pocket. These tablets had the following numbers, (838) on one side and the following letter, (TEVA). I retrieved these tablets, and I placed them in an evidence bag. I later handed Ofc. J. Young with the evidence bag containing these tablets. Ofc. J. Young later processed and packaged the tablets and placed them into the Key West Property Division as evidence.

Sgt. A. Rodriguez responded on scene to speak with Ryan and document the injuries he sustained. Ryan sustained minor abrasions on his face, elbows and wrists.

Ofc. J. Young placed Ryan in the rear passenger seat of my patrol vehicle. I later secured Ryan by placing the seatbelt

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on. I later transported Ryan to the Lower Keys Medical Center to get him medically cleared. My In-car Axon camera was activated during the transport, (3722). While I was in-route to the Hospital, Ryan managed to pull his pants down and pulling his underwear down. When we arrived at the Hospital, and I opened the door, I noticed Ryan's pants and underwear were down close to his knees. Ryan stated that he defecated in the rear passenger seat and also said, "I pissed myself". I assisted getting Ryan out of my patrol vehicle and then I pulled his pants up to escort him inside the Hospital. Ryan in fact defecated in the rear passenger seat of my patrol vehicle. This was captured with my in-car Axon camera, (3722).

While Ryan was seated on the bed at the Hospital, he attempted to throw himself to the ground. I had to stand near the bed to prevent Ryan from falling to the ground. Ryan began coughing and began turning his head to the right side of his body. I told Rayn to please stop turning his head towards my direction and he willingly began coughing close to my arm. Ryan said, "I have AIDS and I hope you get it". Ryan became belligerent and yelling extremely loud. I told Ryan to lower his voice while other people at the Hospital were being treated and he said, "I don't fucking care" several times. Ryan was medically cleared from the Hospital shortly after. I removed Ryan's feces from the rear seat and then I cleaned up the seat to remove his urine as well. I sanitized the seat and then placed Ryan in the rear seat of my patrol vehicle, (My in-car Axon camera was activated, 3722).

I transported Ryan to the Monroe County Detention Center.

Ofc. Roman contacted Poison Control via phone to get the tablets identified. Ofc. Roman spoke with the operator and the pills were identified as 1 milligram Clonazepam, (Scheduled 4 controlled substance). Report number provided by Poison Control, (M3708183).

Based on the facts and evidence, Ryan Reeves, did knowingly and willfully oppose to follow my verbal instructions while performing my legal duties as a Police Officer. Ryan was a passenger of a vehicle Ofc. Hesse conducted a traffic stop on. While Ofc. Hesse was conducting a DUI investigation, I remained standing near the front passenger seat where Ryan was seated. Ryan later exited the golfcart and walked back and forth over the sidewalk. Ryan became agitated to the extent that he took several steps towards me and getting approximately 2-3 feet away from me. I told Ryan to not get close to my face 3 times during this incident. Ryan leaned his upper body close to my face and I remained standing near the curb of the road in the same spot. Ryan displayed an antagonistic demeanor for no reason. Ryan extended his right arm close to my chin by approximately 8 inches and as he was extending his arm, I redirected his right hand, and I escorted him to the ground by performing a modified straight arm/leg sweep takedown after his active resistance. I was wearing my class B uniform with the Key West Police insignia on my sleeves. I was recognizable as a Police Officer. I informed Ryan he was detained and not free to leave during this traffic stop. Contrary to F.S.S 843.02.

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Based on the facts and evidence, Ryan Reeves, was in actual possession of a controlled substance without a prescription. Incident to arrest lead to the discovery of two tablets that had the following numbers, (838) on one side and the following letter, (TEVA). Contrary to F.S.S. 893-16(A).
