A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE ATTACHED "FINAL MILE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT" (ILA) BETWEEN THE CITY AND THE KEY WEST HOUSING AUTHORITY (KWA) FOR INSTALLATION AND MAINTENANCE OF CERTAIN BIKE AND PEDESTRIAN AMENITIES WITHIN KWA PROPERTIES; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of Key West was awarded "Final Mile" FDOT grant funding to increase bike and pedestrian amenities along the US 1 corridor, including bus stops at the Henry V. Haskins Senior Citizen Plaza on Kennedy Drive and at Poinciana Gardens Senior Living Community on Duck Avenue and 17th Street, which are both within KWA property; and

WHEREAS, the "Final Mile Interlocal Agreement" sets forth the respective responsibilities of the City and KWA regarding installation and maintenance of such amenities; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the attached "Final Mile Interlocal Agreement" between the City of Key West and the Key West Housing Authority is hereby approved.

Section 2: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the Presiding Officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
