**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING FAB ADVENTURES, INC. TO CONDUCT THE JOY RIDE EVENT ENDING AT THE EDWARD B. KNIGHT PIER ON SATURDAY, NOVEMBER 23, 2024, FROM 7:00 A.M. TO 6:00 P.M.; PURSUANT TO TERMS AND CONDITIONS SET FORTH BY THE CITY MANAGER; AUTHORIZING THE CLOSURE OF CERTAIN STREETS THEREOF FOR THE JOY RIDE ON SATURDAY, NOVEMBER 23, 2024 FROM 7:00 A.M. TO 6:00 P.M.; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE**

**WHEREAS** FAB Adventures, Inc. request permission to hold the Joy Ride on Saturday, November 23, 2024, from 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Commission of the City of Key West, Florida.

**SECTION 1.** That in Resolution 19-174, the City Commission directed the city Manager to "develop language that restricts the use of polystyrene by individuals on public property, temporary vendors on public property, or entities engaged in a contractual relationship with the local government for the provision of good or services, unless such use is otherwise preempted by law."

**SECTION 2.** "That the vendor/lessee/licensee acknowledges the City's concern about the negative environmental impact of using disposable polystyrene products, which are neither readily recyclable nor biodegradable. Vendor/Lessee/licensee/contractor therefore, commits to refrain from the use or distribution of single-use polystyrene/plastic items, including but not limited to single-use polystyrene/plastic straws, bags, plastic

utensils and "to go" packages for food or products sold on any property leased from the City"

**SECTION 3.** That FAB Adventures, Inc. is hereby granted permission to conduct the Joy Ride on the day and during the hours stated above; PROVIDED that all trash is adequately collected and contained; that a guarantee indemnifying the city is executed; that the organization meet the terms and conditions set forth by the City Manager.

**SECTION 4.** FAB Adventures, Inc. will adhere to the recycling plan of the City of Key West, that one (1) recycling container for everyone (1) trash barrels will be used and that they will be placed side by side.

**SECTION 5.** That the Joy ride will be ending at the Edward B. Knight Pier.

**SECTION 6.** That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signatures of the presiding officer and Clerk of the Commission.
