A RESOLUTION OF THE CAROLINE STREET CORRIDOR AND BAHAMA VILLAGE COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY (CRA) AWARDING THE BID OF FLOWERS CHEMICAL LABORATORIES IN RESPONSE TO ITB #027-16 FOR WATER TESTING AT THE KEY WEST BIGHT AND THE KEY WEST BIGHT FERRY TERMINAL IN THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF \$29,550.00; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT IN SUBSTANTIAL CONFORMANCE WITH THE BID DOCUMENTS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CAROLINE STREET CORRIDOR AND BAHAMA VILLAGE COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the bid of Flowers Chemical Laboratories in response to ITB #027-16 is hereby awarded in the total amount of \$29,550.00, for water testing at the Key West Bight (water testing at the City Marina at Garrison Bight will be included in the signed contract, as approved in simultaneous City Commission Resolution No. 16-317).

Section 2: That the City Manager is authorized to execute a contract in substantial conformance with the bid documents, upon consent of the City Attorney.


Section 3: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the presiding officer and the Clerk of the Agency.



ACTION STATEMENT

Resolution approving the award for Invitation to Bid (ITB) #027-16 Water Testing to Flowers Chemical Laboratories, Inc. for the Key West Bight Ferry Terminal and the Key West Bight Marina in the amount of \$29,550 and authorize the City Manager to execute the contract.

BACKGROUND

Key West Bight Marina is required as part of its submerged land lease to perform quarterly and annual water testing for the following parameters:

- Dissolved Oxygen
- BOD5
- Ph
- Total N, NO₂-N, NO₃-N, and unionized ammonia
- Total P and Ortho – PO₄-P
- Oil and Grease
- Fecal and total coliform
- Polycyclic aromatic hydrocarbons (PAHs)
- Arsenic
- Cadmium
- Chromium VI
- Copper
- Lead
- Zinc

Dissolved Oxygen and Fecal and total coliform are sampled quarterly with the other parameters sampled the 4th quarter or the annual sampling event. The testing results are reported to DEP so that the water quality of the marina can be monitored. Any upward fluctuation in a parameter may indicate water quality is changing and additional investigation or sampling may be warranted.

MEMORANDUM

The City Marina at Garrison Bight has performed the annual testing voluntarily for the past several years. Testing results have always been satisfactory at both marinas.

The Key West Bight Management District Board approved this item at their October 12, 2016 meeting.

PURPOSE & JUSTIFICATION

ITB #028-16 was advertised on August 29, 2016 seeking bids from qualified individuals or firms for water testing services.

Flowers Chemical Laboratories, Inc. was the sole respondent for the project. Staff has reviewed their submittal and found them responsive to the ITB. The following is a breakdown of their pricing per location:

FINANCIAL IMPACT

Funds will be used from the Key West Bight Marina Operations account #405-7503-575-3100 for the Key West Bight and the Key West Bight Ferry Terminal testing Services. Funds for the City Marina will come from the 413 account.

Key West Bight Management District Board recommends approving the award for Invitation to Bid (ITB) #027-16 Water Testing to Flowers Chemical Laboratories, Inc. for the Key West Bight Ferry Terminal and the Key West Bight Marina in the amount of \$29,550 and authorize the City Manager to execute the contract.


