A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING PARADISE CHARITABLE FOUNDATION TO CONDUCT PARROT HEADS IN PARADISE STREET PARTY ON FRIDAY, NOVEMBER 5, 2010 FROM 8:00 A.M. TO 6:00 P.M. PURSUANT TO TERMS AND CONDITIONS SET FORTH BY THE CITY MANAGER; AUTHORIZING THE CLOSURE OF THE 500 BLOCK OF DUVAL STREET BETWEEN FLEMING & SOUTHARD STREETS; GRANTING A SPECIAL EVENT PERMIT PURSUANT TO SECTION 6-86 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES FROM 8:00 A.M. TO 6:00 P.M.; AUTHORIZING THE SALE AND CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES WITHIN THE ENCLOSED AREA; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, Paradise Charitable Foundation wishes to conduct Parrot Heads in Paradise Street Party as a fundraiser on Friday, November 5, 2010 on the 500 block of Duval Street.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Commission of the City of Key West, Florida;

SECTION 1. That Paradise Charitable Foundation is hereby granted permission to conduct Parrot Heads in Paradise Street Party on the day and during the hours stated above; **PROVIDED** that all trash is adequately collected and contained; that a guarantee indemnifying the city is executed; that the organization meet the terms and conditions set forth by the City Manager; and that 25% of gross revenue or \$1,000.00, whichever is greater, shall be donated to Paradise Charitable Foundation.

SECTION 2. That Paradise Charitable Foundation is hereby granted permission for the closure of Duval Street between Fleming and Southard Streets on the date and during the hours stated above.

SECTION 3. That Paradise Charitable Foundation is hereby granted a Special Event Permit under Section 6-86 of the Key West Code of Ordinances for an event that will take place

and time herein described.

SECTION 4. That pursuant to Section 18-86 of the Key West Code of Ordinances, Paradise Charitable Foundation is hereby granted permission allowing the sale and consumption of alcoholic beverages within the enclosed area.

SECTION 5. That Paradise Charitable Foundation will adhere to the recycling plan of the City of Key West.

SECTION 6. This Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signatures of the presiding officer and Clerk of the Commission.
