

RESOLUTION NO. 24-036

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING SLOPPY JOE’S ENTERPRISES, INC. TO CONDUCT THE ANNUAL HEMINGWAY LOOK-A-LIKE AND RUNNING OF THE BULLS CONTEST ON SATURDAY, JULY 20, 2024, FROM 11:30 A.M. TO 10:00 P.M. (SET UP 9:00 A.M. TO 11:00 P.M.) PURSUANT TO TERMS AND CONDITIONS SET FORTH BY THE CITY MANAGER; AUTHORIZING THE CLOSURE OF GREENE STREET BETWEEN DUVAL AND ANN STREETS FROM 9:00 A.M. TO 11:00 P.M.; AUTHORIZING THE SALE AND CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES WITHIN THE ENCLOSED AREA; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, Sloppy Joe’s Enterprises, Inc. wishes to conduct the annual Hemingway Days look-alike and Running of the Bulls contest as a fundraiser for Hemingway Look-a-like Society; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Commission of the City of Key West, Florida.

SECTION 1. That in Resolution 19-174, the City Commission directed the City Manager to “develop language that restricts the use of polystyrene by individuals on public property, temporary vendors on public property, or entities engaged in a contractual relationship with the local government for the local government for the provision of good or services, unless such use is otherwise preempted by law.”

SECTION 2. “That the vendor/lessee/licensee acknowledges the City’s concern about the negative environmental impact of using disposable polystyrene products, which are neither readily recyclable nor biodegradable. Vendor/Lessee/licensee/contractor therefore commits to refrain from the use of polystyrene/plastic straws, bags, plastic utensils and “to go” packages for food or products sold on any property leased from the City.”

SECTION 3. That Sloppy Joe’s Enterprises, Inc. is hereby granted permission to conduct the Hemingway Days Annual Look-A-Like Contest and Running of the Bulls on the day and during the hours stated above; PROVIDED that all trash is adequately collected and contained; that a guarantee indemnifying the city is executed; that the organization meet the terms and conditions set forth by the City Manager.

SECTION 4. That Sloppy Joe’s Enterprises, Inc. is hereby granted permission for the closure of Greene Street between Duval and Ann Streets on the date and during the hours stated above.

SECTION 5. That pursuant to Section 18-86 of the Key West Code of Ordinances, Sloppy Joe’s Enterprises, Inc. is hereby granted permission allowing the sale and consumption of alcoholic beverages within the enclosed area.

SECTION 6. That Sloppy Joe’s Enterprises, Inc. must post the required notice regarding prohibition of purchase and sale of alcoholic beverages to persons under 21 years of age.

SECTION 7. That Sloppy Joe’s Enterprises, Inc. will adhere to the recycling plan of the City of Key West, that one (1) recycling container for every one (1) trash barrels will be used and that they will be placed side by side.

SECTION 8. This Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signatures of the presiding officer and Clerk of the Commission.
