



## Narrative

**NARRATIVE OF INCIDENT**  
Subject Morales displayed ACTIVE PHYSICAL RESISTANCE- a person makes physically evasive movements to defeat and officers attempts at control. Subject Morales continually pulled away from officers by twisting and thrashing his body about and trying to walk away after being instructed not to do so.

Ofc Agleev controlled Subject Morales by Response Option. Physical Control- achieving compliance or custody through take-downs. Takedowns- techniques that redirect, in a controlled manner, a person to the ground to limit his physical resistance and to apply appropriate restraint devices. Ofc Agleev used 'double underhooks' by reaching both of arms and hands under the armpits of Subject Morales and grabbing the front of the arms/shoulders. Ofc Agleev then redirected Subject Morales to ground by using a body drag.

Ofc Agleev nor Subject Morales were not injured in this resistance and response. KWFR did respond to the scene because of the odd and erratic behavior displayed by Subject Morales.

Subject Morales was arrested by Ofc G Bozzetti and Ofc T Storey and transported to jail without further incident.

I did respond to the scene and spoke with Subject Morales. He seemed to have a case of amnesia. I did speak with witnesses on scene.
