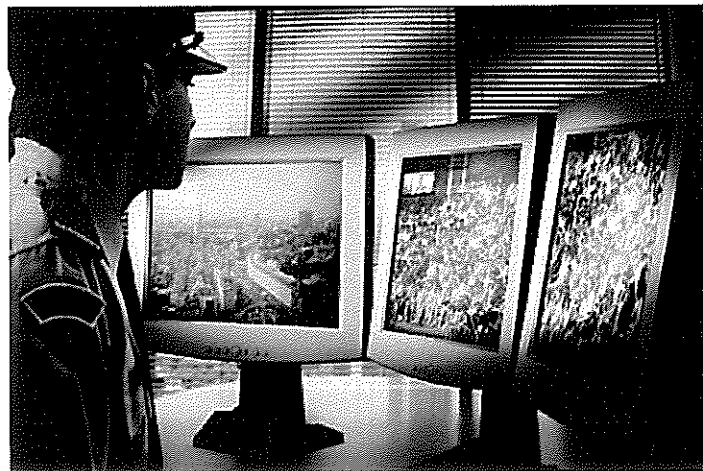

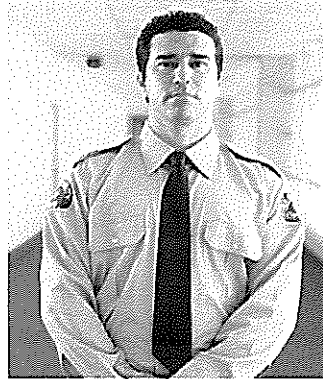



Tactical Protection Corp. is committed to providing a safe, efficient, and productive work environment for all employees. In keeping with this commitment, employees and job applicants may be asked to provide body substance samples to determine the illicit use of marijuana, cocaine, opiates, amphetamines, alcohol, barbiturates, and phencyclidine. Tactical Protection will attempt to protect the confidentiality of all drugs test results. Drug test can be conducted in any of the following situations:

- Pre-employment: As a prequalification to assuming any position, which prospective employees are required to provide a body substance sample for drug testing.
- Periodic: This test occurs in connection with qualifying medical examinations for required licenses.
- Reasonable cause: Test of this kind occurs when a employees exhibits an unusual behavior in the work place. Such behavior must be witnessed by at least one supervisor.
- Post accident: Any guard that gets into a serious accident during working hours, whether on or off the premises of employment must provide a body substance sample to verify the physical condition he/she was under during this accident.
- Random Testing: Employees can be asked to be tested at anytime as per company policy for a drug free environment.

Finally, they must pass the Florida Police department screening of photo, fingerprint, and license statements. It is understood that if an applicant has recently moved to the area a police screening will be obtained from the applicant's home state.
