A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING SOUTHERNMOST BEACH RESORT/SOUTHERNMOST BEACH CAFE TO CONDUCT THE ROOTS ON THE ROCK/BIG GAME TAILGATE AND WATCH PARTY ON SOUTH BEACH ON SATURDAY, FEBRUARY 7, 2026 FROM 1:00 P.M. TO 7:00 P.M. AND SUNDAY, FEBRUARY 8, 2026 FROM 6:00 P.M. TO 11:59 P.M. (OR END OF GAME); PURSUANT TO TERMS AND CONDITIONS SET FORTH BY THE CITY MANAGER; GRANTING AN EXEMPTION FROM THE NOISE CONTROL ORDINANCE PURSUANT TO SECTION 6-86 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES; AUTHORIZING THE SALE AND CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES WITHIN THE ENCLOSED AREA; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Southernmost Beach Resort/Southernmost Beach Café has applied to the city for a Special Event Permit to conduct Roots on the Rock on Saturday, February 7, 2026, from 1:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m., and a Big Game Tailgate Watch Party on Sunday, February 8, 2026, from 6:00 p.m. to 11:59 p.m. (or end of game), on South Beach; and

WHEREAS, Section 6-86 of the Key West Code of Ordinances requires a Special Event Permit to depart from the requirements of the City's Noise Control Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, amplified music will be played during the concert on Saturday, February 7, 2026, from 1:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. and amplified sound for the watch party on Sunday, February 8, 2026, from 6:00 p.m. to 11:59 p.m. (or end of the game).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST FLORIDA.

SECTION 1. That in Resolution 19-174, the City Commission directed the City Manager to "develop language that restricts the use of polystyrene by individuals on public property, temporary vendors on public property, or entities engaged in a contractual relationship with the local government for the local government for the provision of good or services, unless such use is otherwise preempted by law."

SECTION 2. "That the vendor/lessee/licensee acknowledges the City's concern about the negative environmental impact of using disposable polystyrene products, which are neither readily recyclable nor biodegradable. Vendor/Lessee/licensee/contractor therefore commits to refrain from the use of polystyrene/plastic straws, bags, plastic utensils and "To go" packages for food or products sold on any property leased from the City."

SECTION 3. That Southernmost Beach Resort/Southernmost Beach Cafe are hereby granted a Special Event Permit under Section 6-86 of the Key West Code of Ordinances for an event that will take place at the time and place as herein described; PROVIDED that all trash is adequately collected and contained; that a guarantee indemnifying the city is executed; and that organization meets the terms and conditions set forth by the City Manager.

SECTION 4. Section 6-86 of the Key West Code of Ordinances requires a Special Event permit to depart from the requirements of

the City's Noise Control Ordinance.

Section 5. There will be live amplified music on Saturday, February 7, 2026, from 1:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. and amplified sound on Sunday, February 8, 2026, from 6:00 p.m. to 11:59 p.m. (or end of game).

SECTION 6. That Southernmost Beach Resort/Southernmost Beach Cafe will adhere to the recycling plan of the City of Key West, that one (1) recycling container for every one (1) trash barrels will be used and that they will be placed side by side.

SECTION 7. That pursuant to Section 18-86 of the Code of Ordinances, Southernmost Beach Resort/Southernmost Beach Cafe is hereby granted permission allowing the sale and consumption of alcoholic beverages within the enclosed area.

SECTION 8. That Southernmost Beach Resort/Southernmost Beach Cafe must post the required notice regarding prohibition of purchase and consumption of alcoholic beverages to persons under 21 years of age. Proof of compliance with Supplement F, paragraph 3 of the application is required at least ten (10) days in advance.

SECTION 9. That Southernmost Beach Resort/Southernmost Beach Cafe acknowledges that they are responsible for payment to the Key West Police Department, the Key West Fire Department and Community Services.

SECTION 10. That this Resolution shall go into effect

immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signatures of the presiding officer and Clerk of the Commission.
