A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING JIATF SOUTH TO HOLD THE ANNUAL VETERANS DAY PARADE ON DUVAL STREET FROM 4:00 P.M. TO 8:00 P.M. TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 11, 2014; AUTHORIZING THE CLOSURE OF CERTAIN STREETS OR PORTIONS THEREOF FOR SAID PARADE FROM 4:00 P.M. TO 8:00 P.M.; WAIVING ALL FEES FOR REQUIRED CITY SERVICES; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Commission of the City of Key West, Florida, as follows:

Section 1. That JIATF South is hereby granted permission to hold the annual Veterans Day Parade on Duval Street from 4:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. Tuesday, November 11, 2014, and the City will close portions thereof from 4:00 p.m. to approximately 8:00 p.m. for said parade.

Section 2. That pursuant to Section 6-26 (c), for cause shown upon the record, a special exception to the requirement of payment for required city services set forth in Section 6-26 (a) is hereby granted, waiving all fees for required city services for the Veterans Day Parade.

Section 3. That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signatures of the presiding officers and Clerk of the

Commission.
