An application was received for the heavy maintenance trimming of one (1) **Tropical Almond tree**. A site inspection was done on February 14, 2013 and documented the following:

Tree Species: Tropical Almond (Terminalia catappa)





Diameter: 42"

The Tropical Almond tree is a not protected tree unless the tree is over 24" in diameter. The applicant is requesting a permit to do some heavy maintenance trimming on the tree.

Recommendations: Approval of the heavy maintenance trimming of the tree with the condition that the tree must be maintained in a healthy condition for a period of one year by a certified arborist. If the tree becomes sick and dies within the year, then mitigation will be required.
