

RESOLUTION NO. 13-177

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, SUPPORTING THE VIETNAM LIVING MEMORIAL PROPOSAL; DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO WORK WITH THE ORGANIZERS TO REVIEW PLANS FOR COMMISSION APPROVAL; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, a dedicated number of local Vietnam veterans have devoted much time and energy into developing a proposal to recognize the more than two hundred Key West citizens who fought in the Vietnam War;

WHEREAS, the organizers wish honor and recognize the men and women who served and sacrificed their lives in the Vietnam War by erecting a memorial in Bayview Park; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission recognizes and applauds the efforts of all Vietnam Veterans, as well as all current and past service members who have served in America's conflicts; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission supports the Vietnam Memorial Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the Key West City Commission supports the Vietnam Living Memorial Proposal and directs the City Manager to work with the organizers to bring a plan before the City


Commission for final approval.

Section 2: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the presiding officer and the Clerk of the Commission.

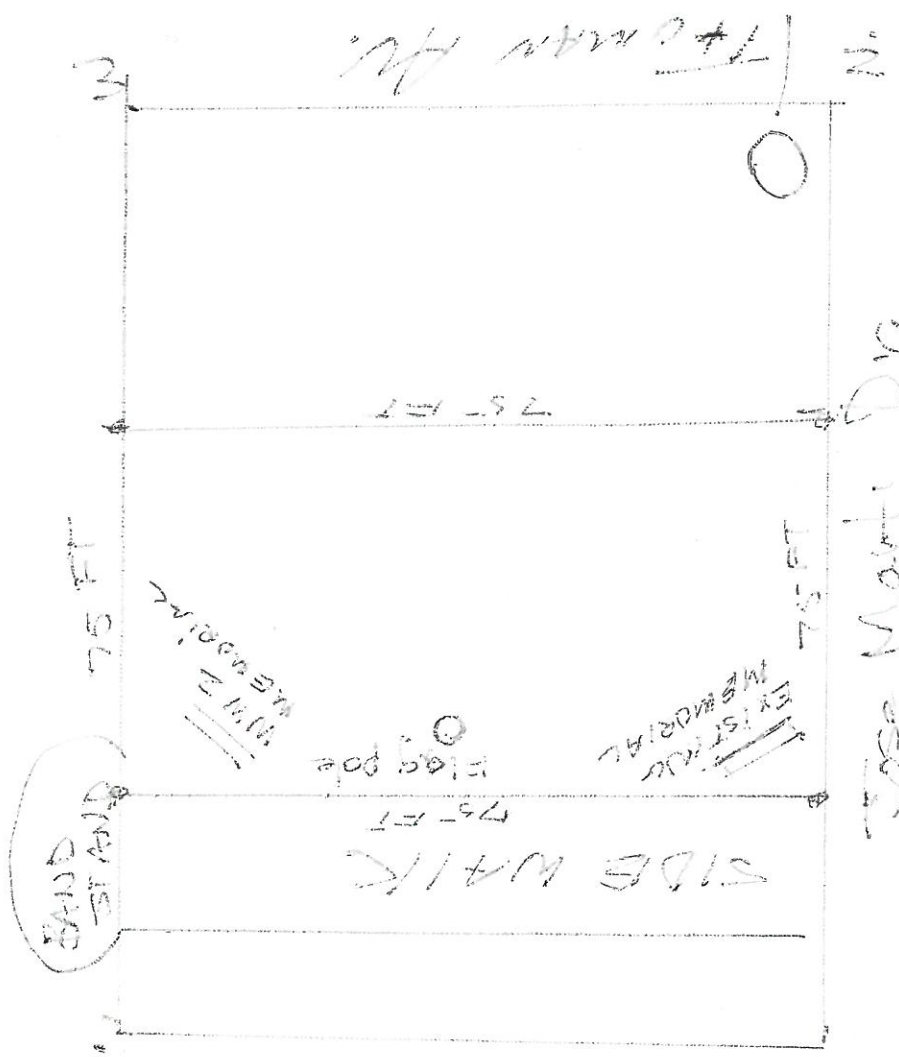
