



- Southernmost Point Plaza Construction underway. Reverted to traditional curbed roadway.
- **North Roosevelt Blvd RRR** (446011-1)(446011-2) RRR Construction underway with pedestrian improvements. Safety Improvements programmed for future.
- US1 and East College Rd Signalization (449756-1-52-01) Construction est. 2026. Allows for easier bus turning movements and includes roadway bicycle detection. Letting in Sept.
- George St Improvements Construction est. 2026




WHEN DID CRASHES OCCUR?



FATALITIES AND SERIOUS INJURIES BY YEAR








December Sustainable Transportation Update

- Safe Streets and Roads for All (SS4A) grants
 - The Key West Safety Action Plan will be completed by early 2026
 - Promoting the safety issue map https://ufl.maps.arcgis.com/apps/webappviewer/index.html?id=4af89680a42540589e99e 120451c4bd8
 - Florida law went into effect on July 1, 2025
 - Working with Multimodal Transportation Coordinator on a Letter to the Commission
 - E-bike amendment to Senate Bill 462 allows Key West to do e-bike enforcement on sidewalks along N Roosevelt Blvd
 - SB 462 permits local jurisdictions to require anyone who rides a bike to carry a photo ID and set an age registration
 - Attended Florida Bicycle Summit, which discussed how HB 243 was filed to improve e-bike and e-moto safety
 - Partnering with City of Marathon and Village of Islamorada on SS4A
 - Apply for FDOT's Transportation Alternative funding (due December 4)

Transit

- Researching short- and long-term innovative transit funding ideas
 - Purchasing Via's Remix software, which will help with transit planning and scheduling
 - Verifying bus stops in the field using Automated Transit Stop Inventory Management (ATSIM) system
 - Possibility of launching carshare on City-owned parking spaces
 - Exploring how to create ads on existing free WiFi on buses
 - Deciding how to proceed with the bus shelter ads contract
- Prepare to apply for T-Mobile Hometown Grant to buy artistic bus shelters

Exemplary E-Bike Program

- Scheduled meeting with Multimodal Transportation Coordinator and We Cycle to discuss feasibility of using Quick Rides app to launch bikeshare
 - Bikeshare would help Key West receive higher League of American Bicyclists' Bicycle Friendly Community award (due June 17)
 - Purchasing Sportworks' 3-position bike racks for every transit vehicle and Velolink sensors and software
 - Velolink will track bike rack usage for every transit vehicle
 - Florida Senate Bill 700, which went into effect on July 1, preempts local jurisdictions from regulating EV charging stations and supporting equipment
