A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF A CHARGEPOINT BATTERY ELECTRIC BUS (BEB) CHARGING STATION AND CHARGER, PURSUANT TO SECTION 2-797(3) OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST CODE OF ORDINANCES IN THE AMOUNT OF \$228,989.00; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ANY NECESSARY DOCUMENTS, AMENDMENTS AND BUDGET TRANSFERS, UPON CONSENT OF THE CITY ATTORNEY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Key West has previously approved the purchase of a 35-foot Gillig Battery Electric Bus (BEB) through Resolution 24-009, passed in January 2024, which necessitates the acquisition of a compatible charging station and charger to ensure efficient and reliable operation; and

WHEREAS, the procurement of the ChargePoint Battery Electric Bus (BEB) Charging Station and Charger is essential for the full recharging of the bus within eight hours or less, depending on the initial state of charge, and includes two plug-in dispensers, a six-year extended warranty, a three-year network service plan, and comprehensive training ; and

WHEREAS, the City of Key West intends to procure the ChargePoint BEB Charging Station and Charger from Gillig, Inc., by piggybacking on the Pinellas County Transit Authority (PSTA) Florida Electric Transit Buses with Charging & Associated Equipment - RFP 21-980369, pursuant to Section 2-797(3) of the City of Key West Code of Ordinances, which allows for purchases under contracts of the federal

government, the state, or its political subdivisions; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager has confirmed that the contract pricing under RFP 21-980369 is fair and reasonable based on a good faith review and discounted pricing provided; and

WHEREAS, the acquisition of the ChargePoint BEB Charging Station and Charger will be fully reimbursed under the FDOT 5311 Capital Grant - PTGA G3101 at 100%, incurring zero cost to the City; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: The City Commission hereby authorizes the procurement of the ChargePoint Battery Electric Bus (BEB) Charging Station and Charger from Gillig, Inc., in an amount not to exceed \$228,989.00, pursuant to Section 2-797(3) of the City of Key West Code of Ordinances. The acquisition will be fully reimbursed under the FDOT 5311 Capital Grant - PTGA G3101, ensuring no cost to the City.

Section 2: The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute any necessary documents, amendments and budget transfers upon consent of the City Attorney.

Section 3: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the Presiding Officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
