The "P" parking symbol shall be made of 1/4" thick 5083 alloy aluminum plate with an added 1/2" deep return at the edge. Front and back of the sign face shall be frisket painted with a high gloss UV protection and graffiti clear coat. The Lot Number sign shall be made of 1" thick greenheart wood with the text routed 1/4" into the wood and painted filled. Finished both sides.
