A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, APPROVING AMENDMENT 1 TO TASK WORK ORDER NO. 4 (TITLED "TASK WORK ORDER NO. 4S2") WITH CHOICE ENGINEERING CONSULTANTS, INC. IN THE AMOUNT OF \$13,400.00 FOR SUPPLEMENTAL FIELD INVESTIGATION IN CONJUNCTION WITH FLAGLER AVENUE PEDESTRIAN IMPROVEMENTS (PROJECT TA49032101), PURSUANT TO SECTION 2-845 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES; AUTHORIZING ANY NECESSARY BUDGET TRANSFERS OR ADJUSTMENTS; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ANY NECESSARY DOCUMENTS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, in Resolution No. 18-143 the City Commission approved a general traffic engineering contract with Choice Engineering Consultants, Inc. and in Resolution 21-063, the contract was renewed for two years; and

WHEREAS, Choice Engineering was issued Task Work Order No. 4 for Flagler Avenue Corridor - Pedestrian Improvements, authorized by the City Manager in an amount below the purchasing threshold for signalization/roadway plans at the intersections of Flagler Ave and First Street/Bertha Street and Flagler and Eisenhower Drive; and

WHEREAS, the consultant determined that additional work is necessary to determine the presence and location of utilities adjacent to the project limits, and City staff recommends approval of the additional work, at a cost that

will bring the Task Order above the cost threshold which requires Commission approval; and

WHEREAS, the requested change order represents more than 5% of the total contract value of the project, and Section 2-845 of the Code of Ordinances requires City Commission approval of any change order in excess of five percent of any public service building or capital improvement project; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That Amendment No. 1 to Task Work Order No. 4 (Titled "Task Work Order No. 4S2") for supplemental field investigation in conjunction with the Flagler Street Pedestrian Improvements Project (Project TA49032101) is hereby approved in the amount of \$13,400.00 (total Task Work Order cost \$54,521.92), pursuant to Section 2-845 of the Code of Ordinances.

Section 2: That funding for the Flagler Avenue Pedestrian Improvements Project (TA49032101) is budgeted in Transportation Alternative Fund Account #111-4903-549-6300. Any necessary budget transfers and adjustments are hereby authorized.

Section 3: That the City Manager is authorized to execute any necessary documents, upon the advice and consent of the City Attorney.

Section 4: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the Presiding Officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
