A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, SUPPORTING FLORIDA SENATE BILL 74 WHICH, IF PASSED, WOULD PROHIBIT THE USE OF HAND-HELD WIRELESS COMMUNICATIONS DEVICES WHILE DRIVING; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, on January 18, 2012 in Resolution No. 12-042, the City Commission urged the adoption of legislation prohibiting texting while driving; and

WHEREAS, City staff has received notice that the Florida Legislature is considering SB 74, which would prohibit the use of hand-held wireless communications devices while driving, under most circumstances, and provide for penalties; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the Key West City Commission supports SB 74 and urges its legislators to support such measures.

Section 2: That the City Clerk is hereby authorized to transmit a certified copy of this Resolution to Representative Raschein, Senator Bullard, and Governor Rick Scott and members of the House and Senate leadership.

Section 3: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the presiding officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
