bid schedule; and

WHEREAS, at its meeting of July 12, 2023, the Key West Bight Management District Board made a recommendation to the CRA to award 3-year contracts in accordance with documents contained in the ITB to Gulfstream Construction & Development, LLC and Sea Tech of the Florida Keys, Inc. through Resolution KWB #23-14; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CAROLINE STREET CORRIDOR
AND BAHAMA VILLAGE COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the bids of Gulfstream Construction & Development, LLC and Sea Tech of the Florida Keys, Inc. in response to ITB #23-013 for Construction Services - Key West Historic Seaport are awarded.

Section 2: That the seaport has budgeted for maintenance and repair projects in different accounts and will specify the account the funds are to be drawn from with the issuance of each task order.

Section 3: That the City Manager is authorized to execute 3-year contracts in substantial conformance with documents contained in the bid package on behalf of the City of Key West, upon advice and consent of the City Attorney.

Section 4: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the presiding officer and the Clerk of the Agency.

Introduction

Resolution approving Gulfstream Construction & Development, LLC and Sea Tech of the Florida Keys, Inc. for ITB #23-013 Construction Services Contract - Key West Historic Seaport and authorizing the City Manager to execute a three (3) year contract, subject to City Attorney review.

Background

The Key West Historic Seaport contains multiple buildings of various age and condition. These buildings are leased to tenants for use as restaurants, bars, dive and baits shops, and tourist related retail. As these buildings age, the Seaport is finding that the exterior repairs, such as doors, windows and siding, are becoming more prevalent, along with structural issues arising on a regular basis. Most lease agreements list the owner as the responsible party for these types of repairs.

Under the existing construction services contract, several task orders have been issued for various repairs around the Seaport including emergency repairs due to storm events. Seaport Staff believe the General Construction Services contract has been successful in completing many of the owner required repairs throughout the Seaport and is a useful tool in getting these repairs done in a timely manner.

ITB #23-013 Construction Services was advertised for an indefinite quantities contract for needed maintenance and repairs for buildings located at the Key West Historic Seaport. Three contractors responded to the ITB and provided hourly labor rates and percentage mark-up for mobilization, materials and additional subcontractors not listed in the request.

The following pricing submitted is inclusive of overhead and profit.

Staff has reviewed the submittals and found Gulfstream Construction & Development, LLC and Sea Tech of the Florida Keys, Inc. to be responsive, and recommend award of three-year agreements for the Construction Services Contract. One contractor, Gulf-Atlantic Construction Group, Inc., was determined to be non-responsive for an incomplete bid schedule. The Key West Historic Seaport will establish the locations and scope of work as maintenance and repair work become necessary. Task Orders will identify the scope of each specific project and payment will be based on the above unit prices.

The Key West Bight Management District Board approved this item at their July 12, 2022, meeting through Resolution KWB #23-14.

The Seaport has budgeted for maintenance and repair projects in different accounts and will specify the account the funds are to be drawn from with the issuance of each task order.

Recommendation

The City Manager's Office recommends the Mayor and Commission approve the award of both Gulfstream Construction & Development, LLC and Sea Tech of the Florida Keys, Inc. for the ITB #23-013 Construction Services Contract - Key West Historic Seaport and authorizing the City Manager to execute a three (3) year contract, subject to City Attorney review. The Agreement may be renewed at the discretion of the Bight Board and the Community Redevelopment Agency.
