### **Description of Work:**

**Minor Development Plan** – Demolition of non-contributing tennis pro shop, 3-tennis court complex shade structure and non-historic bathrooms.

### **Site Facts:**

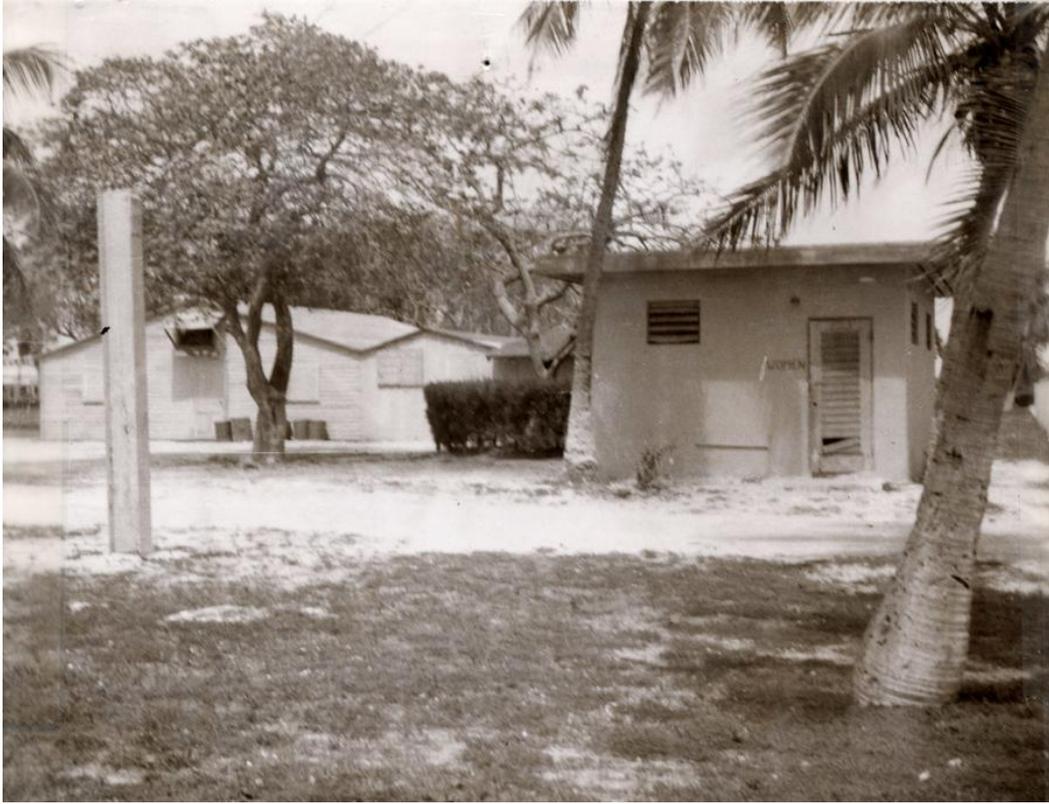
The site under review is located within Bayview Park, a historic public park in Key West consisting of approximately six acres. The park was created in the 1920s through efforts led by the Key West Rotary Club, transforming vacant land into a public recreational space. The land was previously owned by Eduardo H. Gato, and his residence, which once stood on the property, was later relocated to another location. The park originally had a view of the bay, which contributed to its name. In 1924, the pavilion and bandstand were constructed and dedicated by the United Daughters of the Confederacy. Over time, the park has incorporated additional commemorative features, including the José Martí Memorial and the Key West Veterans Memorial Garden honoring Vietnam veterans. Bayview Park remains an important recreational and community gathering space and is home to the Boys and Girls Club, which relocated to the park in 2002. The site is currently located within an X flood zone and an AE-6 flood zone. Approved by Planning Board on February 19, 2026.

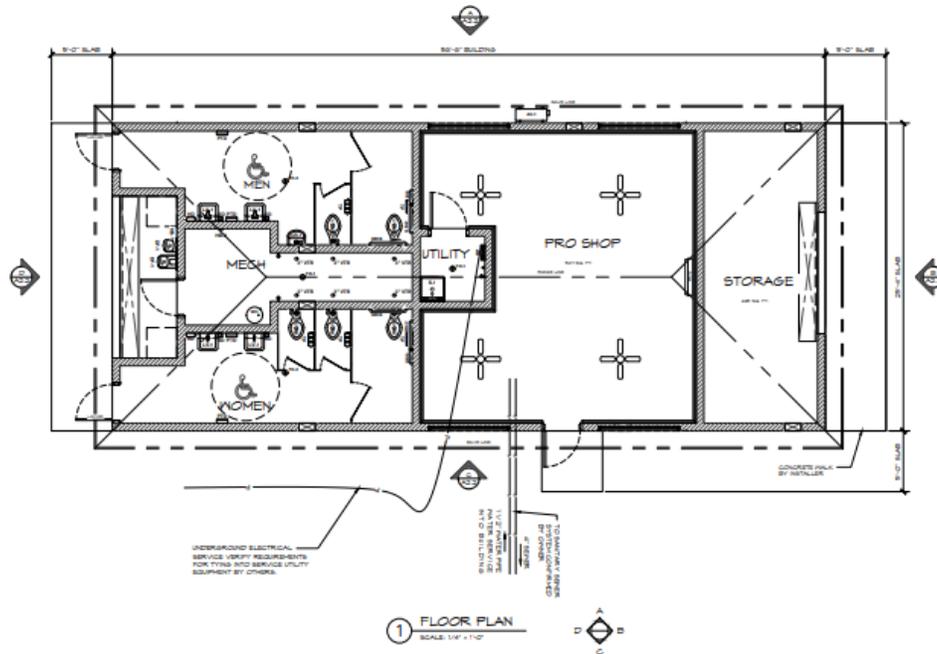

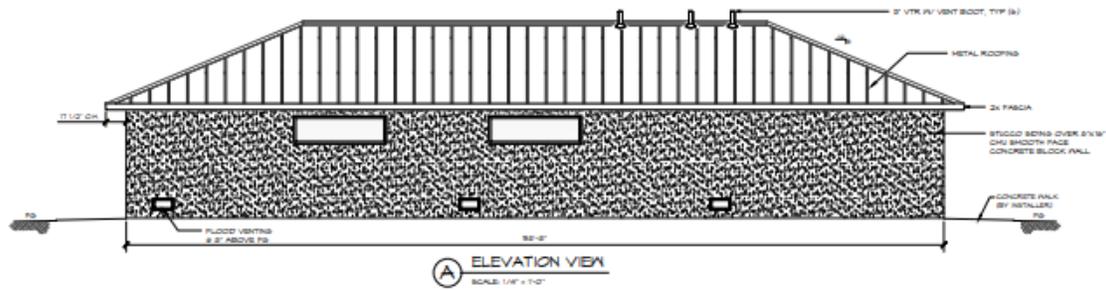

### **Staff Analysis:**

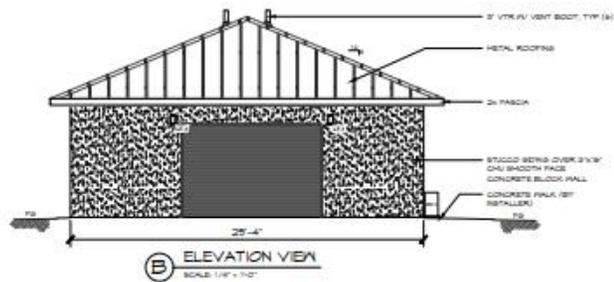
A Certificate of Appropriateness is currently under review for a new one-story structure, new 3-tennis court complex shade structure and site improvements. The one-story structure will house the pro shop, bathrooms, and storage space. There will also be vending machines on the northeast elevation covered by a metal rolling security grill door. It will feature a 5 v-crimp metal roof, stucco finish on all elevations, a garage style door on the southwest elevation where storage will be located, and aluminum doors and windows with an approximate height of 14' - 4 11/16". The shade structure will be located by the three tennis courts in the same location as the existing shade structure. It will feature steel beams, steel columns, and metal roofing with a total height of 11' - 3 1/2". Site improvements include bike fix-it stations and bike racks. Phase 1 was approved in June 2025, and this is Phase 2. Proposed demolition includes the non-contributing tennis pro shop (seen in the c1965 historic photo), the three-court shade structure, and the non-historic bathrooms (built in 2010).



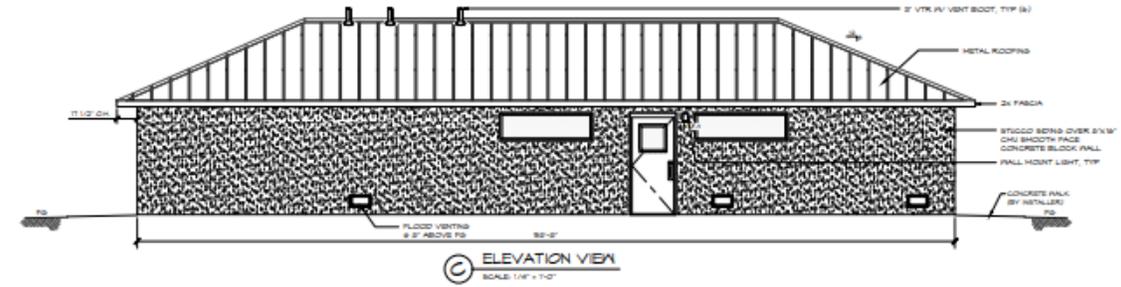
*Proposed floor plan for one-story structure.*



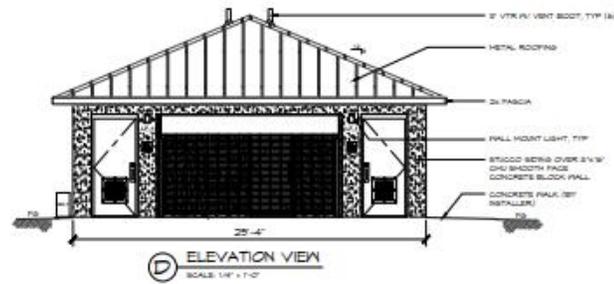
*Proposed southeast elevation for one-story structure. (facing park)*

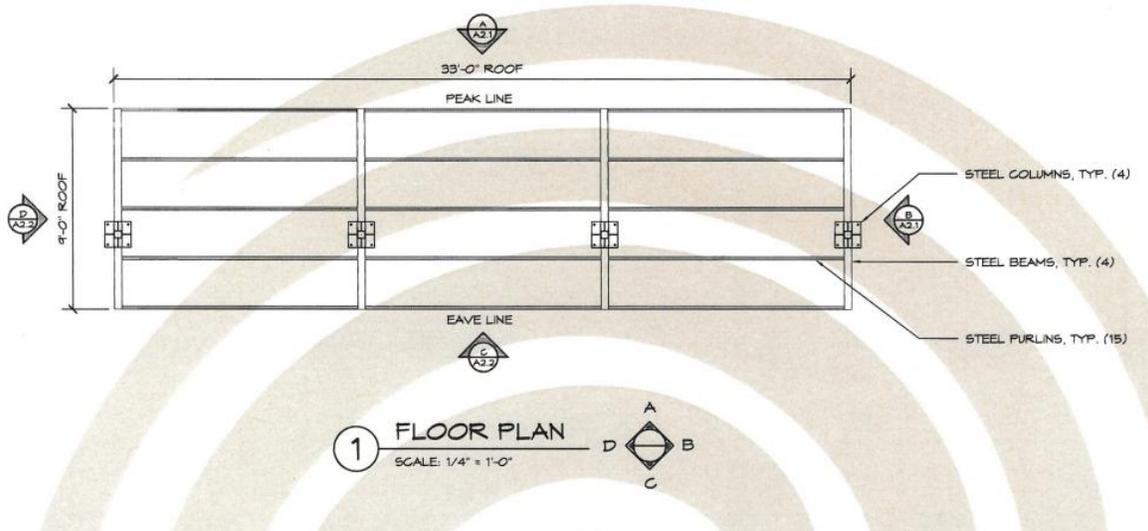

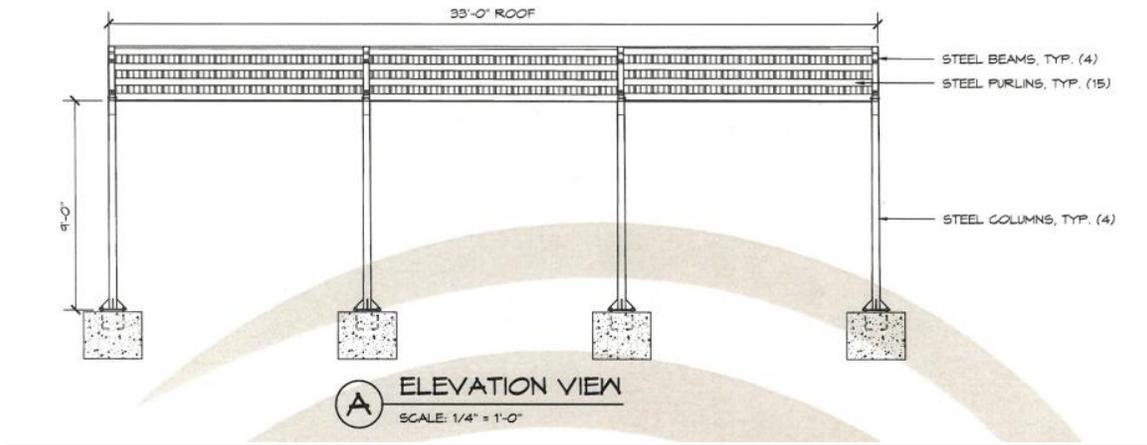

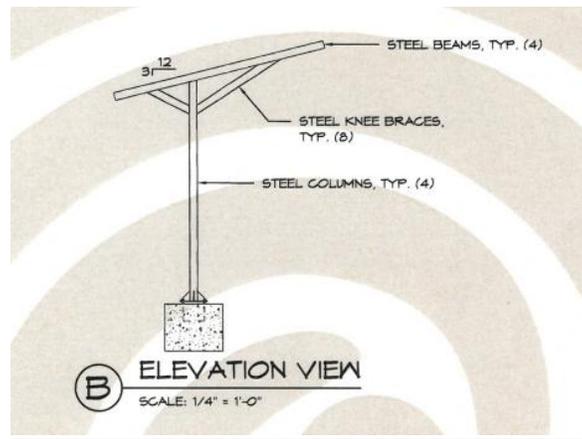
*Proposed Site Plan. (1 and 2 part of Phase 2)*

### **Consistency with Cited Guidelines:**

The proposed improvements are generally consistent with the HARC Guidelines. The new one-story structure is modest in scale and designed to support recreational uses within Bayview Park, housing a pro shop, restrooms, and storage. The use of a 5V-crimp metal roof and stucco exterior finish reflects materials commonly found in Key West and compatible with surrounding park structures. However, the elevation facing Truman Avenue is mostly solid with minimal openings. As this is a highly visible frontage, the HARC Guidelines for New construction encourage appropriate openings and articulation (*Guidelines 7 and 25*), and the current design appears very plain.

The proposed shade structure will be located in the same area as the existing tennis court shade structure. Its steel framing and metal roof are typical for recreational facilities and remain subordinate to the surrounding area. Additional site improvements, including bike repair stations and bike racks. This proposal represents Phase 2 of the Bayview Park improvements, following Phase 1 from June 2025.

### **Criteria for Demolition:**

It is staff's opinion that the request for this demolition shall be based on the demolition criteria of Chapter 102 Section 218 (a) of the LDR's. The criteria for demolition of historic structures state the following:

*(a) The historic architectural review commission shall issue a certificate of appropriateness for an application for demolition:*

- (1) If the subject of the application is a contributing or historic building or structure, then it should not be demolished unless its condition is irrevocably compromised by extreme deterioration, or it does not meet any of the criteria of section 102-125(1) through (9).*

It is staff's understanding that some elements proposed for demolition exhibit deterioration, the pro shop and shade structure are weathered and have termite damage.

The following is the criteria of section 102-125:

- 1 Embodies no distinctive characteristics of a type, period, or method of construction of aesthetic or historic significance in the city and is not a significant and distinguishable building entity whose components may lack individual distinction.*

The elements proposed for demolition do not exhibit significant architectural characteristics.

- 2 Is not specifically associated with events that have made a significant contribution to local, state, or national history.*

It is staff's understanding that the structures proposed for demolition are not associated with any events that have made a significant contribution to local, state, or national history.

- 3 Has no significant character, interest, or value as part of the development, heritage, or cultural characteristics of the city, state, or*

*nation, and is not associated with the life of a person significant in the past.*

It is staff's understanding that the elements under review have no significant character and are not associated with the life of a significant person in the past.

- 4 *Is not the site of a historic event with a significant effect upon society.*

It is staff's understanding that the structures proposed for demolition are not associated with any significant events.

- 5 *Does not exemplify the cultural, political, economic, social, or historic heritage of the city.*

It is staff's understanding that the elements under review do not exemplify the cultural, political, economic, social or historic heritage of the city.

- 6 *Does not portray the environment in an era of history characterized by a distinctive architectural style.*

It is staff's understanding that the elements proposed for demolition do not exhibit a distinctive architectural style.

- 7 *If a part of or related to a square, park, or other distinctive area, nevertheless should not be developed, or preserved according to a plan based on the area's historic, cultural, natural, or architectural motif.*

It is staff's understanding that, although the structures are located within Bayview Park, they are not historically significant features of the park and are not integral to its historic, cultural, natural, or architectural character.

- 8 *Does not have a unique location or singular physical characteristic which represents an established and familiar visual feature of its neighborhood or of the city, and does not exemplify the best remaining architectural type in a neighborhood; and*

Although the structures are located in Bayview Park, they are not significant features of the park. They do not have unique characteristics or a prominent location, and they are not a recognizable or important part of the park's overall character.

9 *Has not yielded, and is not likely to yield, information important in history.*

Staff believes that based on current documentation, the elements under review have not yielded, and are unlikely to yield, any historically significant information.

Based on the above criteria, staff finds the proposed work meets the criteria for demolition. If approved, this will be the only required reading. Staff will review submitted construction plans for demolition and design to ensure consistency with submitted drawings.

Proposal is to demolish the aging and deteriorating non-contributing bathroom structure and tennis pro shop.
Bathroom structure was constructed in 2010 and therefore is non-contributing and non-historic.
The Pro Shop and shade structure were built in the 1970s and are non-contributing to the historic development of Bayview Park and the historic district.

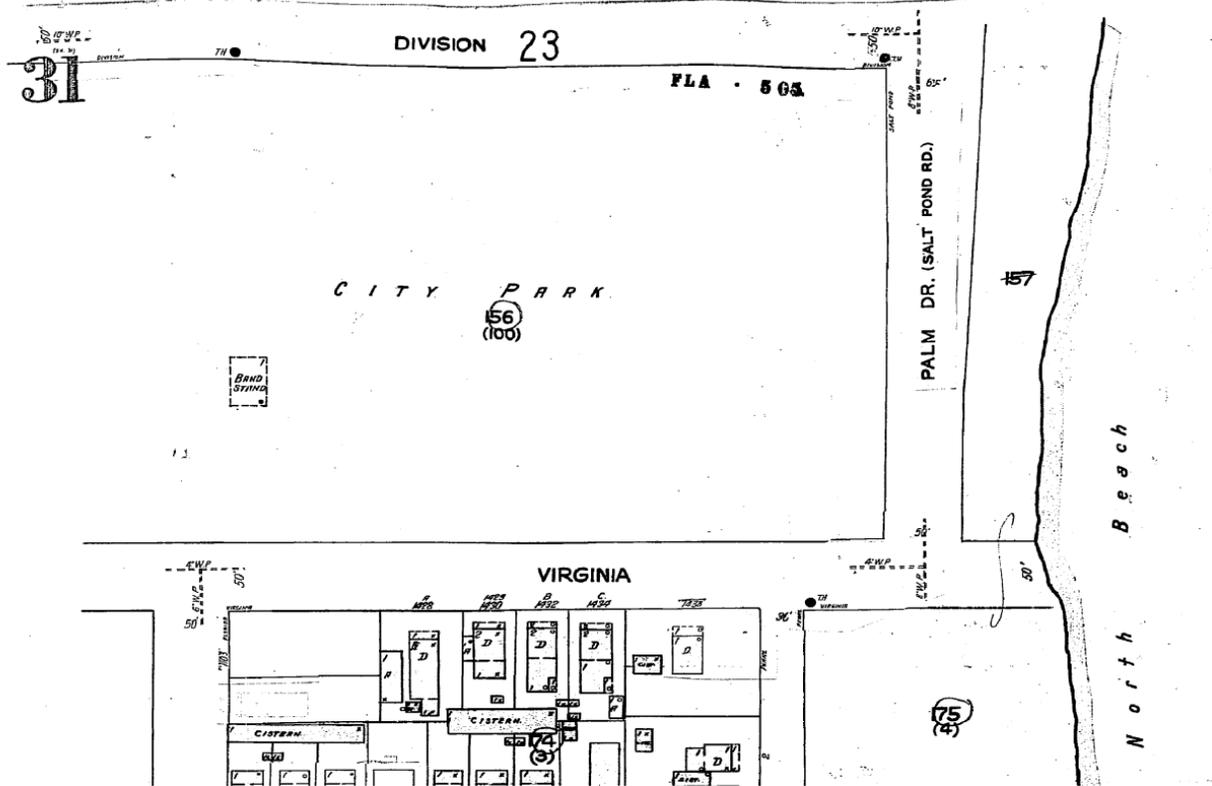
1962 Sanborn Map

# Installation Cane Stop

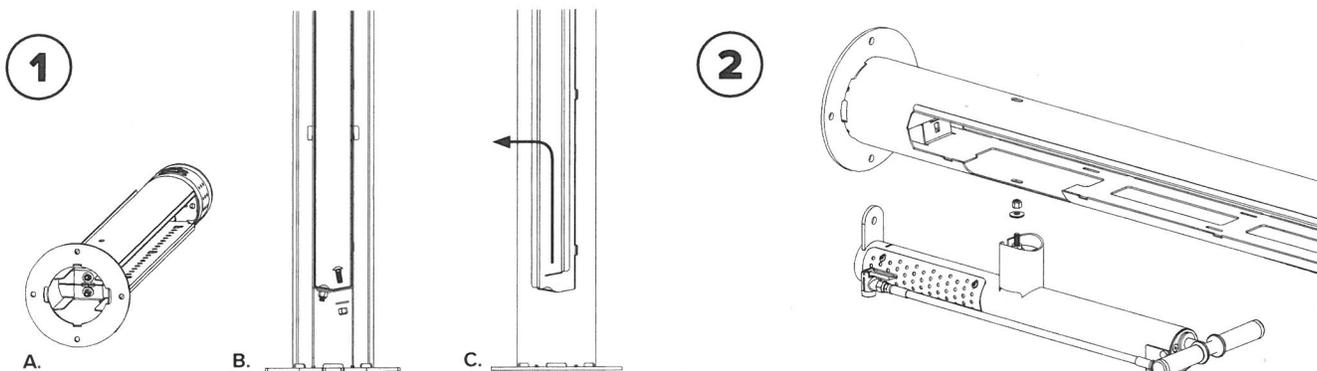
See diagrams below for guidance on installing the optional Cane Stop. This attachment provides a cane-detectable barrier beneath the hanger arms of the Fixit for improved safety.



## NOTE

All threads for all parts of the pump are right-hand threads. They tighten clockwise, and loosen counter-clockwise ("righty tighty, lefty loosey"). However, when you are looking top-down at a bolt that threads from underneath, if you move it counter-clockwise from your point of view, you are actually tightening, not loosening, the nut! This has led to some unnecessary breakage of pump parts. Be sure you are looking at the nut with the proper orientation before tightening or loosening.
