A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, PURSUANT TO SECTION 2-797(3) AND (4) (b) OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF THE MITEL MiVOICE CONNECT PHONE SYSTEM FROM IPC TECHNOLOGIES, TO INCLUDE LICENSING, HARDWARE AND UPGRADE SERVICES, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$149,288.51, UTILIZING THE SOURCEWELL COOPERATIVE PURCHASING AGREEMENT MITEL BUSINESS SOLUTIONS SYSTEMS CONTRACT NUMBER 120122-MBS; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ANY NECESSARY RELATED DOCUMENTS AND BUDGET TRANSFERS/ADJUSTMENTS, UPON CONSENT OF THE CITY ATTORNEY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Section 2-797(3) of the City's Code of Ordinances authorizes purchases pursuant to government contract; and

WHEREAS, the City of Key West purchased its current MITEL MiVoice Connect System in FY 2015-2016 and has maintained upgrades to the system throughout its service life. As of December 2025, MITEL Networks Corporation will no longer provide system updates, patches or security updates to the City's current Mitel MiVoice Connect phone system; and

WHEREAS, the City's current system has met its expected lifespan and can no longer serve the future needs of the City of Key West's modern workforce. The replacement path for the City's current system is the Mitel MiVoice Business platform which will provide a highly reliable and redundant platform that leverages modern datacenter technologies and redundant communications paths; and

WHEREAS, as a global MITEL Platinum Partner, IPC Technologies has provided a reasonable and responsive quote for the purchase of the Mitel MiVoice Business platform which includes the licensing, hardware and upgrade services needed; and

WHEREAS, Section 2-797(3) of the City's Code of Ordinances authorizes purchases under government purchasing cooperative programs; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 2-797(4)(b) of the City's Code of Ordinances, the City Manager has determined that the purchase of the Mitel MiVoice Business platform from IPC Technologies, to include licensing, hardware and upgrade services as described in the attached price quote, is in the best interests of the City;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Pursuant to Section 2-797(3) and Section 2-797(4)(b) of the City's Code of Ordinances, and in the best interests of the City, the City Commission hereby authorizes the purchase of the Mitel MiVoice Business platform, to include licensing, hardware and upgrade services, from IPC Technologies in an amount not to exceed \$149,288.41 utilizing the Sourcewell Cooperative Purchasing Agreement MITEL Business Systems 120122-MBS contract.

Section 2: That the City Commission finds that adequate funds for this purchase are budgeted and available in FY 25-26 in the Information Technology Infrastructure Account No. 101-1303-513-6400 (Infrastructure Surtax Machinery & Equipment).

Section 3: That the City Commission hereby authorizes the City Manager to execute any necessary related documents and budget transfers/adjustment, upon consent of the City Attorney.

Section 4: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the Presiding Officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
