#### Infrastructure Type Project Updates

- S Roosevelt Blvd Construction wrapping up. Target completion date Spring 2025.
- Staples Ave Pedestrian Bridge Permanent counter base installed at east end.
- Caroline St (TIF) Bicycle infrastructure awaiting construction phase.
- South St Largely complete. Bicycle signage installed, pavement speed marking installed.
- Southernmost Point Plaza Bid release imminent.
- Wickers 60% design. Limited funding allocation.
- North Roosevelt Blvd at Palm Ave (434684-4-52-01) Largely complete
- **North Roosevelt Blvd** (446011-1) Safety Audit completed and a reduction of three crashes per year can be achieved by recommendations: access management, driveway width, LPI, etc. Letting stage.
- **US1 and East College Rd Signalization** (449756-1-52-01) Construction est. 2026. Allows for easier bus turning movements and includes roadway bicycle detection.
- Truman Ave and White St Signalization (434684-5-52-01) Crosswalk and signalization improvements

  - Applying for Planning and Demonstration grant by June 26 to fund near-miss sensors and a traffic crash dashboard
    - Exploring future regional grant application with Islamorada and Marathon
- E-bike amendment to CS/HB 567
  - Word "within" AND the e-bike age restriction made it through the Florida Senate, waiting for Governor DeSantis to sign
  - FDOT approved slow down signs that were installed on sidewalks and trails throughout Key West
- Community Energy Workshop on June 6 and 7 at the Bahama Village Community Center
  - Informed the public and received feedback on EV charging stations, mobility hubs, transportation demand management (TDM), and Mobility as a Service (MaaS)
