A RESOLUTION OF THE CAROLINE STREET CORRIDOR AND BAHAMA VILLAGE COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY (CRA) AWARDED THE BID OF EBSARY FOUNDATION COMPANY IN RESPONSE TO ITB #20-005 IN A TOTAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$485,500.00 FOR DOCK REPAIR AND PILING REPLACEMENT FOR THE KEY WEST HISTORIC SEAPORT (KB1505); AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE NECESSARY DOCUMENTS IN CONFORMANCE WITH THE BID DOCUMENTS, UPON CONSENT OF THE CITY ATTORNEY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, five responsive bids were opened on December 18, 2019, in response to ITB #20-005, and at its meeting of February 12, 2020, the Key West Bight Management District Board recommended award of bid to the lowest responsive bidder; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CAROLINE STREET CORRIDOR AND BAHAMA VILLAGE COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the bid of Ebsary Foundation Company is hereby awarded in an amount not to exceed \$485,500.00, in response to ITB #20-005, the terms and conditions of which are incorporated herein.

Section 2: That funding for this project is budgeted in account 405-7503-575-6300 (Project No. KB1505).

Section 3: That the City Manager is authorized to execute any necessary documents, in conformance with the bid documents, upon the advice and consent of the City Attorney.

Section 4: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the presiding officer and the Clerk of the Agency.
