TO 11:00 P.M; GRANTING A SPECIAL EVENT PERMIT PURSUANT TO SECTION 6-86 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES FROM 9:00 A.M. SECTION 2. That the Wesley House Family Services, Inc. is hereby granted permission for the closure of Caroline Street between Duval and Simonton Streets and Ann Street from Greene Street to Caroline Street on the date and during the hours stated above.

SECTION 3. That the Wesley House Family Services, Inc. is hereby granted a Special Event Permit under Section 6-86 of the Key West Code of Ordinances for an event that will take place and time herein described.

SECTION 4. That pursuant to Section 18-86 of the Key West Code of Ordinances,

permission is granted to allow the sale and consumption of alcoholic beverages within the enclosed area.
