Disembarkment Fee: \$10.50 per passenger, no crew charge

Security Fee: \$.63 per passenger, no crew charge

Passenger Count is based on CBP Form 1300 Vessel Clearance Statement

Ferry Terminal Fee: \$4.00 per passenger, no crew charge. Security Fee: \$.63 per passenger, no crew charge

Addition security fees may apply if passenger counts are too low to cover security costs of port call. Additional fees are charged as follows:
