An application was received for the removal **of one (1) Mahogany tree.** A site inspection was done on November 27, 2012 and documented the following:

Tree Species: Mahogany (*Swietenia mahagoni*)





Diameter: **20.5 inches dbh**

Location: 40% - Foundation issues

Species: 100% - On protected tree list

Condition: 40% - Poor health

Total Average Value = 60%

Value x Diameter = replacement caliper (dbh) inches

.60 x 20.5" dbh = **12 replacement caliper (dbh) inches**

Recommendations: **Staff recommends approval of the removal.**

The tree's root system has already done damage over the years; Now that the house is being renovated and the foundation is being rebuilt the owner does not want the tree to keep doing what it has been doing

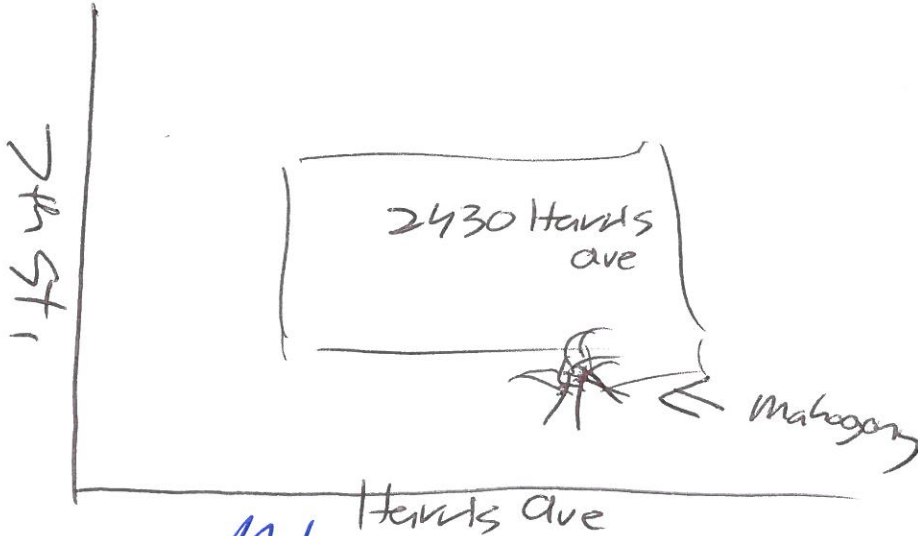
