- 4. <u>Simonton St Police Station</u> Building has been painted. "Naming" mural Call for proposals in draft form budget approved \$5,000.
- 5. Frederick Douglass Community Center Ongoing. Liz working with Council's designer on signage for Craig and Billy. Sally is in fabrication phase. Sally Binard presented final design to BVRAC on 8/14. Craig Gray and Billy Kearins are complete
- 6. <u>State of Florida Seal</u>- Working on repairs to reinstall over United St. exit door in Commission Chambers. Artist has been traveling extensively rescheduled for September. Artist had surgery this is postponed until January.
- 7. <u>Truman Waterfront Park</u> Ongoing Phase 1B Draft RFP for pairs of double "barn" doors facing the new sports field with an art budget of \$15,000.
- 8. <u>Simonton Street Fire Station</u> <u>Ongoing</u>. Review with Board and HARC to determine appropriate targeted space for RFP and discuss guidelines with new HARC Director.

Met with Sustainability coordinator in July applying for a NEA grant for new bus shelters for island areas that do not have them will consider artistic designs and room for poetry revolving program. ONGOING conversations on pieces removed and how to proceed. 4 have been removed and need to be replaced.
