A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE PROCUREMENT OF PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING SERVICES FROM JACOBS ENGINEERING GROUP, INC., FOR DESIGN, PERMITTING, BID PHASE AND SUPPORT DURING CONSTRUCTION FOR REPLACEMENT OF TWO (2) EFFLUENT PUMPS AND MANIFOLD SYSTEM AT THE RICHARD A. HEYMAN ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION FACILITY IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$209,546.00, PURSUANT TO SEC.2-841, CODE OF ORDINANCES, CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA; AUTHORIZING A BUDGET TRANSFER IN THE AMOUNT OF \$9,546.00; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ANY NECESSARY DOCUMENTS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Key West owns, operates and maintains the Richard A Heyman Environmental Protection Facility; and

WHEREAS, when the facility was constructed in 1989, two pumps were installed and both pumps are necessary to meet the redundancy requirement of Rule 62-600.300(2) (b), F.A.C.; and

WHEREAS, the replacement of the two (2) originally installed effluent pumps is required to maintain operation of the effluent disposal system and remain in compliance with the State of Florida Domestic Wastewater Facility Permit, FLA147222; and

WHEREAS, City staff recommends procurement of professional engineering services from Jacobs Engineering Group, Inc. for the design, permitting, bid phase and construction engineering and inspection ("CEI") services for the replacement of two (2) effluent pumps and manifold system at the Richard A. Heyman

Environmental Protection Facility, in an amount not to exceed \$209,546.00 and approval of a budget transfer within the sewer fund in the amount of \$9,546.00; and

WHEREAS, Section 2-841, *Contracts for Professional Services*, Code of Ordinances, City of Key West, Florida authorizes procurement of professional engineering services; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the Commission hereby approves the procurement of professional engineering services from Jacobs Engineering Group, Inc. for the permitting, bid phase and construction engineering and inspection ("CEI") services for the replacement of two effluent pumps and manifold system at the Richard A. Heyman Environmental Protection Facility in an amount not to exceed \$209,546.00.

Section 2. That the Commission hereby approves the requested budget transfer in the amount of \$9,546.00 from Sewer Fund Account #4013501-5359900, Other Uses, to Sewer Fund Account #4013504-5356500, Treatment Plant Operation, and authorizes the City Manager to execute any necessary documents, upon consent of the City Attorney.

Section 3. That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the Presiding Officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
