

RESOLUTION NO. 19-054

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, APPROVING A ONE-YEAR EXTENSION OF THE CONTRACT APPROVED IN RESOLUTION NO. 17-106 BETWEEN THE CITY AND CHARLEY TOPPINO AND SONS, INC. FOR RIGHT OF WAY IMPROVEMENTS; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A ONE-YEAR CONTRACT EXTENSION IN SUBSTANTIAL CONFORMANCE WITH THE CONTRACT DOCUMENTS, UPON ADVICE AND CONSENT OF THE CITY ATTORNEY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, in Resolution No. 17-106 the City awarded a contract for "General Right-of-Way Improvements" to Charley Toppino and Sons, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, the Charley Toppino and Sons has requested, and City staff recommends approval of a one-year extension as described in the contract; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That a one-year extension of the contract between the City and Charley Toppino and Sons, Inc. for the Right-of-Way Improvements Project is hereby approved in accordance with the terms specified in the Contract approved in Resolution 17-106.

Section 2: That the City Manager is authorized to execute a contract extension on behalf of the City of Key West, upon the advice and consent of the City Attorney.

Section 3: Future task orders are subject to City Commission/City Manager approval of identified projects. Unit prices from the current base contract are unchanged.

Section 4: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the Presiding Officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
