A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA AUTHORIZING THE DONATION OF ONE (1) SURPLUS AND OBSOLETE CITY-OWNED TRANSIT BUS (BUS 810) TO LIVELY TECHNICAL COLLEGE IN TALLAHASSEE, FLORIDA; AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF TWO (2) SURPLUS AND OBSOLETE CITY-OWNED TRANSIT BUSES (BUSES 811 AND 812); AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ANY NECESSARY RELATED DOCUMENTS, BUDGET TRANSFERS AND/OR AMENDMENTS PURSUANT TO SECTION 2-771 (3) (c) OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, three (3) City-owned buses, originally acquired for more than \$50,000.00, have exceeded their useful life expectancy of twelve (12) years or 500,000 miles and are no longer in service; and:

WHEREAS, Lively Technical College plays a critical role in advancing workforce development by providing City employees with comprehensive, state-of-the-art training through its Lively Paratransit Instructional Program (LPIP) and others. This program delivers industry-level, hands-on instruction designed to enhance technical expertise, operational proficiency, and professional readiness; and

WHEREAS, city staff recommends donating City-owned Bus 810 to Lively Technical College and dispose of City-owned Buses 811 and 812 to the highest bidder; and

WHEREAS, the Florida Department of Transportation has provided documentation to Key West Transit granting the approval and release of the Lien/Certificate of Titles for these buses, and authorized the City Key West Transit to "utilize as you wish"; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager's Office recommends the City Commission approve the donation of City-owned Bus 810 to Lively Technical College and dispose of City-owned Buses 811 and 812 to the highest bidder;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the City Commission hereby approves the donation of surplus and obsolete City-owned Bus 810 to Lively Technical College, Tallahassee, Florida to provide hands-on training for students.

Section 2: That the City Commission hereby approves the disposal of surplus and obsolete City-owned Buses 811 and 812 to the highest bidder.

Section 3: That the City Commission hereby authorizes the City Manager to execute all necessary related documents and budget transfers/amendments, pursuant to Section 2-771 (3)(c) of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Key West, upon the advice and consent of the City Attorney.

Section 4: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the Presiding Officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
