

## ARTICLE XIII. - COSMETICS

### Sec. 18-701. - Definitions.

The following words, terms and phrases, when used in this article, shall have the meanings ascribed to them in this section, except where the context clearly indicates a different meaning:

\*(Coding: Added language is underlined; deleted language is struck through.)

Cosmetic retailer means any business, person or firm that offers for sale cosmetic products in an amount over \$75.00 U.S. Dollars, or who offers cosmetic product samples wherein said samples are applied on customers in any form, with or without an associated fee. The cosmetic retailer and his, her or its employees and agents also constitute the "permit holder" hereunder.

Customer means any person entering upon the business premises of or engaging in discussion with a cosmetic retailer for the purpose of inquiring about cosmetics offered for sale, sampling, or negotiating a purchase, or actual purchasing cosmetics held for sale by a cosmetics retailer.

Historic district shall mean all property located within the following zoning districts of Key West: HRO, HRCC-1, HRCC-2, HRCC-3, HRCC-4, HMDR, HHDR, HNC-1, HNC-2, HNC-3, HCT, HCL, HPS, HPS-1 and HPRD.

Permit holder means cosmetics retailer.
