#### Narrative

NARRATIVE OF INCIDENT

On Sunday, 10/26/25, at approximately 0340 hours, I (Ofc. Lashley) responded to the intersection of Charles Street and Duval Street in reference to a male subject detained by Ofc. Osbourne and Ofc. Howell. Upon my arrival, I observed Ofc. Osbourne and Ofc. Howell with a male later identified as Anthony Brian Manera. Both officers informed me that Anthony had been detained after resisting officers during a disturbance outside Rick's Bar.

Sgt. Waite stated he initially observed Anthony engaged in a heated, face-to-face argument with another unidentified male in front of the establishment. The argument was loud and drew the attention of nearby pedestrians. Sgt. Waite approached to intervene and instructed both parties to separate to prevent the disturbance from escalating. The unidentified male complied and walked north on Duval Street, but Anthony remained in the area and attempted to continue following the male while shouting at him. Sgt. Waite gave Anthony multiple lawful verbal commands to walk south on Duval Street to diffuse the situation. Anthony ignored these commands and instead attempted to walk north toward the other individual.

As Sgt. Waite and Ofc. Sonnichsen attempted to guide Anthony southbound, Anthony forcefully pulled his arms away, tensed his body, and twisted in an attempt to break free from their grasp. Officers gave clear and repeated verbal commands to stop resisting, which Anthony disregarded. For officer safety and to regain control, Sgt. Waite, Ofc. Osb and Ofc. Ofc. Osborne. took Anthony to the ground in a controlled manner and placed him in handcuff restraints. Even while handcuffed, Anthony continued to resist by stiffening his arms, pulling away, and shouting at officers.

Once secured, I placed Anthony in the rear of my patrol vehicle and transported him to the Monroe County Detention Center without further incident.

Based on my investigation and the observations of Sgt. Waite and assisting officers, there is probable cause to believe that Anthony Brian Manera did commit the offense of Disorderly Conduct in violation of F.S. 877.03, by engaging in a loud, tumultuous, and threatening argument in a public place, causing public alarm and disrupting the peace and order of the area.

Furthermore, there is probable cause to believe that Anthony did commit the offense of Resisting an Officer Without Violence in violation of F.S. 843.02, by knowingly and willfully resisting, obstructing, or opposing uniformed law-enforcement officers in the lawful execution of their duties through his repeated refusal to obey lawful commands and physical efforts to pull away from officers attempting to detain him.

My body-worn camera and in-car camera were activated during the encounter and have been uploaded to Evidence.com.
